

## **BOURBON**

### **1792 SINGLE BARREL 11**

Flavors of rich butterscotch and caramel notes, delicately balanced with hints of fruit and toffee. Mash bill: 75% corn, 15% rye and 10% barley 98.6pf

### **BAKERS SINGLE BARREL 16**

Age: At least 7 years. Bold and spicy, with loads of soft vanilla, wood spice, and luscious caramel notes. Mash bill: 77% Corn, 13% Rye, 10% Malted Barley 107pf

### **BAKERS 13 YEAR SINGLE BARREL 2019 RELEASE 25**

Rye spice is the first pop on the nose, with following touches of vanilla, butterscotch, and cherrywood. A hint of cinnamon combines with tart black cherry, seasoned wood and charred notes. Mash bill: 77% corn, 13% rye, 10% malted barley. 107pf

### **BALCONES TEXAS POT STILL 18**

Aromas of honeycrisp apples, toasted oak, kettle corn, graham cracker, oiled glove. Palate begins with honey, sweet cream, candied pecans, sandalwood, and leather, and finishes soft and sweet, along with a drying and tannic fade with lingering spice. 92pf

### **BARDSTOWN FUSION #3 18**

Blend of 18% of Bardstown's three-year-old wheated mash bill (68% corn, 20% wheat, 12% malted barley), 42% of Bardstown's high-rye mash bill (60% corn, 36% rye, and 4% malted barley) along with 40% of a 13-year Kentucky bourbon (74% corn, 18% rye, 8% malted barley). Green apple with honey joining roasted nuts and caramel exemplify the fusion between youthful and aged bourbon. 98.9pf

### **BARDSTOWN FUSION #6 18**

Blend of 56% of Bardstown's three-year-old high-rye mash bill (75% corn, 21% rye, 4% malted barley), 14% of Bardstown's 3 year low-rye mash bill (75% corn, 15% rye, and 10% malted barley) along with 30% of an 11-year Kentucky bourbon (75% corn, 13% rye, 12% malted barley). Baked apples with toffee, walnut, and cinnamon lead to luscious maple with vibrant spice. Our richest Fusion blend to date unfolds with a signature smooth finish. 97.9pf

### **BARDSTOWN DISCOVERY #2 34**

Blend of 44% of a 10-year-old Kentucky bourbon (75% corn, 13% rye, 12% malted barley), 49% of a 12-year Kentucky Bourbon (74% corn, 18% rye, and 8% malted barley) along with 17% of a 14-year Kentucky bourbon (78% corn, 10% rye, 12% malted barley). Maple, a burst of cinnamon, and ripe pear on top of aged leather comprises this complex aroma. A warm palate reveals tannic oak embedded in rich flavor. 122.2pf

### **BARRELL BOURBON BATCH #22 22**

Mash bill: corn, rye, and malted barley. Distilled and aged in KY and IN. Selection of 5-year-old barrels. Delicate florals & honeysuckle on the nose with a hint of freshly crushed herbs such as juniper berry, fennel, and angelica. Well-integrated oak lays a gentle foundation of honey cookie, vanilla toffee and cola. A rich entry on the palate - oily and sweet. The creamy texture evokes flan and cappuccino, along with more rye and cinchona bark. 116.6pf

### **BARRELL BOURBON BATCH #24 20**

Distilled and aged in TN, KY and IN. Selection of 9, 10, 13, and 15-year-old barrels. The nose opens with hints of apple blossom, tobacco, and spruce, alongside notes of banana, ripe pear, lychee, and cherry. On the plate, chocolate ganache is balanced by tart grapefruit, dried porcini mushrooms, and a touch of ginger, cardamon, and black pepper. Finishes creamy and sweet, with notes of maple and a light cherry cordial along with clove. 113.9pf

### **BARRELL BOURBON BATCH #25 20**

A blend of straight Bourbon Whiskeys. Distilled and aged in Tennessee, Kentucky and Indiana. Selection of 5.5, 9, 13, and 15-year-old barrels. Nose opens on pineapple, plum, apple jelly, and honeydew melon, with a light touch of corn pudding and stroopwafel. On the palate, strawberry rhubarb pie, juicy fig and sour orange make for a bright and zesty arrival. It grows richer as you savor a mouthful, developing cappuccino, macadamia nut and leather. More herbaceous than the nose, here allspice is joined by cassia and licorice root. 113.4pf

### **BARRELL BOURBON BATCH #31 22**

A blend of straight Bourbon Whiskeys. Distilled and aged in TN, KY, and IN. Selection of 6, 7, 10, 15 and 16-year-old barrels. Aged in American white oak barrels. This batch's notes of shortbread cookie, pumpkin pie, peppermint latte, and pine needles match the mood of sweater weather. 111.2pf

### **BARRELL BOURBON BATCH #32 24**

A selection of 5 and 6-year-old barrels with a creamy and tropical profile and a selection of 6, 7 and 10-year-old barrels vatted for their complex, old, woody character. These two sets of barrels were slowly blended over three months. A small group of spice driven 7-year-old barrels with notes of cinnamon toast, coffee bean and chocolate were then carefully added to complete the blend. The result is a decadent and rich bourbon with layers of spice and nuttiness. 115.34pf

### **BARRELL BOURBON NEW YEAR 2020 20**

A selection of 5 and 10-year-old straight bourbon whiskeys. Distilled in TN, KY, IN, NY, and TX. Ripe peach aromas hover over a sweet core of pecan pie, dried fig and hot cocoa in this warm and charming bourbon. Deep and contemplative, tingly mulling spices and meadow herbs vie for attention. A drop of water unleashes an explosion of tropical fruit. 109.4pf

#### **BARRELL BOURBON ARMIDA 24**

Armida is a blend of three Straight Bourbon Whiskeys finished separately in Pear Brandy, Jamaican Rum, and Sicilian Amaro Casks. The ripe, floral pear notes provide a soft entrance into a whiskey that is adorned with hints of spice and arid citrus derived from the Amaro casks (and also the toasty bourbon itself). 112.82pf

#### **BARRELL GOLD LABEL 2021 65 \* 10Z**

Blend of 16 and 17-year-old straight bourbons. Barrels for this release were selected from four different collections: cherry bomb barrels with a rich mouthfeel, nutty oak forward barrels, high proof and high complexity barrels, and barrels with pronounced milk chocolate notes. The last group underwent a secondary maturation in toasted virgin American oak casks before being added to this intricate and seductive blend. 113.54pf

#### **BASIL HAYDEN 14**

Aromas of charred oak and sweet notes of vanilla & caramel with hints of dried fruit. Tastes of charred oak flavors that is complemented with sweet brown sugar, a touch of black pepper, and dried fruit to round it out. A pleasant, lingering charred oak finish with a touch of dried fruit. 80pf

#### **BASIL HAYDEN SUBTLE SMOKE 15**

Aromas of mellow smoke character with a hint of sweet vanilla. On the palate, soft char with a light sweetness reminiscent of butterscotch and maple. Finishes crisp yet delicate smokiness with light toasted hickory wood. 80pf

#### **BASIL HAYDEN TOAST 16**

Consists of an entirely new brown rice mash bill and a secondary finish in toasted barrels. The result is a bourbon with less spice, and deepened notes of sweet caramel with a bright, light mouthfeel. Toasted oak complemented by dried fruit and caramelized sugar on the nose, with toasted wood and vanilla notes on the palate with a light mouthfeel. Finishes with sweet caramel highlights. 80pf

#### **BASIL HAYDEN 10 YEAR 20**

Aromas of big oak, hints of char, vanilla, and rye. Oak tastes are balanced by caramel sweetness and rye spice. Finish is lightly smoky with a subtle hint of char. 80pf

#### **BELLE MEADE SOUR MASH 12**

High-rye Content (30% rye). Non-chill filtered. Nose of maple syrup and caramel with floral fragrances and a citrus zest. On the palate, caramel and vanilla with bold rye spice and hints of apricot. Finish is long and smooth with mellow cherry and plum notes accented by cinnamon. 90.4pf

#### **BELLE MEADE RESERVE 17**

High-Rye Content, with Bourbon that is 7-11 years old. Non-chill filtered. Rich and full-flavored, showing vanilla, caramel, spice, and stone fruits.

#### **BLANTON'S SINGLE BARREL 21**

Sweet notes of citrus and oak. The creamy vanilla nose is teased with caramel and butterscotch, all underscored by familiar baking spices such as clove, nutmeg, or cinnamon. 93pf

#### **BLOOD OATH "PACT 6" 24**

A blend of three whiskeys: 7, 8, and 12-year straight rye-based bourbons, further finished in Cognac casks. Hints of roasted caramel and honeyed raisin on the nose, with toasty oak, cinnamon spice, and light tobacco tones. 98.6pf

#### **BOOKER'S 2020-01 "GRANNY'S BATCH" 20**

The nose starts with spice and hints of vanilla coming through. The taste fills your mouth with flavor and warmth that spreads across your palate, and it has a sweet, lingering finish. 126.4pf

#### **BOOKER'S 2020-02 "BOSTON BATCH" 19**

The color is a rich, light brown. The aroma contains vanilla, toasted nuts and some hints of baking spices. The flavor is full and smooth. 126.5pf

#### **BOOKER'S 2021-01 "DONOHUE'S BATCH" 18**

The aroma has vanilla and some baking spice that makes you want to experience the taste of this batch. The taste is full-bodied and opens in the mouth, with a finish that is pleasant and fulfilling especially in these cold winter months. 125.3pf

#### **BOOKER'S 2021-02 "TAGALONG BATCH" 18**

The deep rich color of Tagalong Batch comes from the mid-to-high rickhouse floor locations where these barrels have matured. With pronounced aromas of caramel and vanilla, balanced with the "sweet brown" wood sugar flavor notes from the charred white oak barrels, this batch carries a bold flavor with a surprisingly clean finish - making you want to come back for another sip. 127.9pf

#### **BUFFALO TRACE 11**

This deep amber whiskey has a complex aroma of vanilla, mint and molasses. Pleasantly sweet to the taste with notes of brown sugar and spice that give way to oak, toffee, dark fruit and anise. This whiskey finishes long and smooth with serious depth. 90pf

#### **BUFFALO TRACE KOSHER HIGH RYE RECIPE 28**

Aged for 7 years. In partnership with the Chicago Rabbinical Council (cRc), Buffalo Trace Distillery produced this Rye Recipe Bourbon Whiskey. Made with the same high-quality grains as Buffalo Trace Bourbon Whiskey, this Kosher spirit was aged in specifically designated Kosher barrels. The balanced taste of this Rye Recipe Bourbon is smooth, yet complex. 94pf

#### **CORBIN CASH SOUR MASH 18**

Aged 4 years. 106pf

#### **EAGLE RARE 15**

Aged for no less than 10 years. The nose is complex, with aromas of toffee, hints of orange peel, herbs, honey, leather and oak. The taste is bold, dry and delicate with notes of candied almonds and very rich cocoa. The finish is dry and lingering. 90pf

#### **EH TAYLOR SMALL BATCH BOTTLED IN BOND 14**

Bottled in bond. Tastes of caramel corn sweetness, mingled with butterscotch and licorice. The aftertaste is a soft mouth-feel that turns into subtle spices of pepper and tobacco. 100pf

#### **EH TAYLOR SINGLE BARREL BOTTLED IN BOND 26**

The aroma carries lightly toasted oak, with dried figs and butterscotch. One sip brings flavors of sweetness balanced with tobacco and dark spices. The finish is just long enough to prepare the palate for another sip. 100pf

#### **ELIJAH CRAIG SMALL BATCH 11**

Mash bill: 78% Corn, 12% Malted Barley, and 10% Rye. Delightfully complex nose with notes of vanilla bean, sweet fruit, and fresh mint. Smooth and warm on the palate; pleasantly woody with accents of spice, smoke, and nutmeg. Finishes long, sweet, and slightly toasty. 94pf

#### **ELIJAH CRAIG BARREL PROOF B520 19**

Non-chill filtered. Caramel with toasted oak, fruit notes of apple and orange. Rich vanilla, caramel, and butterscotch tastes along with spices of black pepper & cinnamon at the back of the palate. Finishes nicely layered showcasing all flavors, fades slowly then lingers as it cools. 127.2pf

#### **ELIJAH CRAIG BARREL PROOF A121 18**

#### **ELIJAH CRAIG TOASTED BARREL 19**

Matured Small Batch is added to a toasted barrel for sweet oak and complexity. Toasted oak and rich caramel on the nose, with a palate that is big, rich, and complex. Delightful spice and pepper notes fade to milk chocolate with just a hint of smoke. On the finish, the complexity continues. Nicely warming, with lingering chocolate and baking spices. 94pf

#### **ELIJAH CRAIG SINGLE BARREL 18 YEARS OLD 35**

2020 Release. Bottled solely from the contents of one expertly chosen barrel. Aged oak is immediately apparent on the nose, along with spiced vanilla and notes of mint and chocolate. Richly textured, nutty, and semisweet. Initial bursts of honey give way to toasted wood and pleasant char. Finishes lively and engaging then lingers with vanilla and pepper. 90pf

#### **EVAN WILLIAMS 1783 SMALL BATCH 10**

Honors the year that Evan Williams founded Kentucky's First Distillery. Oaky vanilla, sautéed butter, and sweet corn on the nose. Tastes Semi-sweet, oaky, and honeyed. Finishes Lean, off dry, and regal. 90pf

#### **EVAN WILLIAMS SINGLE BARREL 11**

Nose of Dark caramel, sweet oak, and charred wood. Palate is Lush and spicy, with oak, honey, apple, and orange notes. Finishes long, graceful, and relaxed. 86.6pf

#### **FOUR ROSES SMALL BATCH 12**

Aged minimum 6-7 years. Includes 4 of the 10 recipes utilized by Four Roses: OBSK, OBSO, OESK, & OESO, combining their two mash bills ( B = 60% Corn, 35% Rye, 5% Malted Barley & E = 75% corn, 20% rye, and 5% malted barley) and two of their yeast profiles ( K = slight spice & O = rich fruit). Nose is mellow with spice, rich fruit, hints of sweet oak and caramel. Palate is soft, with ripened red berries, dried spice, well-balanced, rich. Finishes delicate, smooth, and pleasantly long. 90pf

#### **FOUR ROSES SINGLE BARREL 13**

Complex, full-bodied and smooth with a delicate, long finish that's unbelievably mellow. Utilizes only one recipe: OBSV, with a high-rye (60% corn, 35% rye, & 5% malted barley), utilizing the Delicate Fruit yeast. On the nose, notes of dried spice, pear, cocoa, vanilla and maple syrup. Hints of ripe plum and cherries on the robust, full, and mellow palate. Finishes smooth and delicately long. 100pf

#### **FOUR ROSES SMALL BATCH SELECT 16**

Aged a minimum of 6 years, mingling 6 of the 10 recipes from Four Roses (OBSV, OBSK, OBSF, OESV, OESV, OESK, & OESF), with equal parts high- and low-rye recipe. Yeasts used showcase Delicate Fruit, Slight Spice, and Herbal Notes. Non-chill filtered. Raspberries, clove, and nutmeg aromas. On the palate, apricot, berries, vanilla, and light oak. Finish of lingering spearmint, and a touch of cinnamon. 104pf

#### **FOUR ROSES SINGLE BBL BBL STRENGTH 22**

Aged 10 years, 3 months. Special Barrel Strength Barrel Pick utilizing the low-rye OESK recipe (mash bill: 75% corn, 20% rye, & 5% malted barley) with the Slight Spice yeast strain. 116.6pf

#### **FOUR ROSES SMALL BATCH LIMITED EDITION 45**

2020 Release. Non-chill filtered. Features a 12-year-old Bourbon from the OBSV recipe, a 12-year-old OESV, a 19-year-old OBSK and a 16-year-old OESK. Nose of apple, orange peel, honey & vanilla. On the palate, apricot, pear, and hints of red berries. On the finish, rye spice, light oak, and red fruit. 111.4pf

#### **FOUR ROSES SMALL BATCH LIMITED EDITION 42**

2021 Release. Non-chill filtered. Features a 16-year-old Bourbon OBSV recipe, a 14-year-old OBSQ, a 12-year-old OESK, and a 16-year-old OESV. Floral aromas with ripe berries and rich warm oak. Palate has a touch of plum and orange peel, and delicate spice. Finishes with vanilla cream and dark chocolate. 114.2pf

#### **FREELAND SPIRITS 15**

Mash Bill: 70% corn, 20% rye, 10% malted barley  
Rounded and smooth taste, soft caramel and baked berries layered with vanilla bean, cocoa and spice Aromas of toffee, marmalade, smoked pecan and clove. Blend of 3 and A final rest in Oregon's Elk Cove Pinot Noir barrels adds an element of Pacific Northwest terroir. Oregon bourbon. 92pf

#### **FREY RANCH BATCH NO. 2 16**

Non-chilled filtered. Oak & citrus aromas are met by hints of honey, burnt orange peel and candied orange in a dry, medium intensity. Vanilla and caramel lead way to dried mint, banana chips, candy corn, and dried hay with a long finish of cedar, pepper and treacle. The mash bill is non-gmo corn, winter cereal rye, winter wheat and two-row barley. 90pf

#### **HEAVEN HILL 7 YEAR BOTTLED IN BOND 12**

Warm notes of vanilla, honey, and a rich caramel sweetness on the nose. Smooth, warm, and sweet tastes with a subtle rye spice note; caramel and honey mingle with just enough oak and char to round out the richness. Finishes lingers. 100pf

#### **HENRY MCKENNA 10 YEAR SINGLE BBL 13**

Bottled in bond. Aromas of vanilla, caramel, oak, and a light herbaceous note. Tastes of smooth oak, sharp spices, honey, and sweetness. Finishes long, sweet, and spicy. 100pf

#### **HIGH WEST AMERICAN PRAIRIE 12**

A blend of straight bourbon whiskeys aged from 2 to 13 years. Mash bills: 75% corn, 21% rye, 4% barley malt from MGP; 84% corn, 8% rye, 8% malted barley from undisclosed source; Other whiskey components are undisclosed due to contractual reasons. Nose is light caramel and sweet vanilla. Rich and earthy on the palate with well-balanced flavors of candy corn, honey nougat and sweet corn bread biscuits. Finish of vanilla with a hint of caramel apple. 92pf

#### **HILLROCK ESTATE SOLERA AGED 21**

Finished in 10-year-old Oloroso Sherry casks which give the bourbon floral notes layered with fig, roasted walnuts, candied fruit, and spicy rye. 92.6pf

#### **HILLROCK ESTATE SOLERA AGED SAUTERNES 24**

Aged in used Sauternes barrels to soften the spicy rye and give an added sweetness to the finish. Utilizes a pyramid process of periodically removing a small portion of whiskey from the lowest tier of barrels and an equal measure of new whiskey is added to the top barrels, creating complexity. 90.6pf

#### **JEFFERSON OCEAN AGED AT SEA 20**

Voyage 20. Seafaring bourbon is crafted with 7- & 8-year-old juices that are sea-finished. The barrels cross the equator 4 times aboard Oearch's flagship with the sea air, gentle rocking, and extreme temperature changes contributing to the profile of each cask. On the palate, notes of salted caramel popcorn, tropical fruit. Finish is warm and viscous with a hint of brininess. 90pf

#### **JIM BEAM 10**

Oaky, spicy backdrop. Medium-bodied, with mellow hints of caramel and vanilla. 80pf

#### **JIM BEAM BLACK 11**

Aged longer than the traditional Jim Beam in American White Oak barrels. Full-bodied flavor with notes of smooth caramel and warm oak. 86pf.

#### **JIM BEAM OLD TUB BOTTLED IN BOND 11**

Before Jim Beam Bourbon, the Beam Family made Old Tub®, an unfiltered bonded bourbon. Non-chill filtered. Balance of floral and honey tones, along with oak and clove accentuated by lemon and orange zest, all hinging around the classic Beam cracked peanuts scents. 100pf

#### **JOSEPH MAGNUS BATCH #100 24**

A marriage of straight bourbon whiskey aged in white oak barrels and finished in Oloroso sherry, Pedro Ximénez sherry, and cognac casks. Rich deep flavors with notes of orange citrus, dried dark fruits, and vanilla. Finish is long, silky and lasting, with clove, caramel and a burst of cherries. 100pf

#### **JOESPH MAGNUS CIGAR BLEND BATCH #21 38**

The initial nose is sweet, with enticing aromas of sticky toffee pudding, spice cake, cinnamon rolls, rum raisin. All of these notes press on the palate, coupled with the addition of Jamaican allspice, orange with cloves, citrusy cinnamon, candied ginger, coconut, blackberry jam, and hazelnuts.

#### **KENTUCKY OWL CONFISCATED 32**

Light caramel, leather, and smooth vanilla oak tones dot along the aromatics. Well-rounded, with a slight creaminess, followed by crackling graham cracker and tart cherry. Cinnamon brightens the finish, 96.4pf

#### **KNOB CREEK 9 YEAR 12**

Rich, sweet, woody, full-bodied, fruity. Robust oak taste, with hints of smooth vanilla and layered caramel. 100pf

#### **KNOB CREEK 12 YEAR 16**

Mash Bill: 77% Corn, 13% Rye, 10% Malted Barley. Non-chill filtered and aged for 12 years. Aromatic notes of vanilla cream, toasted oak, crushed peanuts, and baking spice, while hints of toasted marshmallow, a smooth oak, and touch of pie crust follow throughout to an oak-driven but light finish. 100pf

#### **KNOB CREEK QUARTER OAK BOURBON 15**

The flagship Bourbon, normally aged for 9 years in full-sized barrels, is instead aged for 4 years in quarter-sized barrels to accelerate the aging process. On the nose, a blend of brown sweets, char and toasted oak with hints of dried fruits, with sweet, heavy oak with background notes of char, dried fruits and brown spices on the palate, and slightly sweet, charred oak with a lingering dryness on the finish. 100pf

#### **KNOB CREEK SINGLE BARREL RESERVE 9 YEAR 16**

Aged for 9 years as cask strength. Deep and complex flavors of vanilla, nuts, and oak, with aromas of robust vanilla and caramel notes; slightly smoky. Finishes long and full. 120pf

#### **KNOB CREEK SINGLE BARREL 15 YEAR 25**

Limited Edition of their standard mash bill mash bill: 77% Corn, 13% Rye, 10% Malted Barley aged for an extended length of time. Savory and sweet, with a combination of chocolate cherry, brown sugar and caramel along with fresh char, leather, and traces of tobacco. 100pf

#### **LARCENY SMALL BATCH 11**

Wheated bourbon, with a higher amount of wheat. Aromas of fresh bread and toffee, with notes of butterscotch. Tastes of buttery caramel and honey, with a rich mouthfeel. Finishes long, gently sweet and savory. 92pf

#### **LARCENY BARREL PROOF A120 19**

Aged between 6-8 years. Mash bill: 68% Corn, 20% Wheat, 12% Malted Barley. Aromas of toasted bread, with maple and cinnamon. Tastes of rich molasses coats the tongue, with notes of fig and hazelnut. Finishes with nuanced flavor fades into lingering warmth. 123.2pf

#### **MAKER'S MARK 10**

All Maker's Mark Bourbon's use the same mash bill: 70% locally grown corn, 16% red winter wheat, 14% malted barley. Aromas of woody oak, caramel, vanilla and wheat prevail in the nose. Sweet and balanced taste with caramel, vanilla and fruity essences. Smooth and subtle finish. 90pf

#### **MAKER'S MARK 46 11**

The first Maker's Mark Bourbon released utilizing their wood-stave finishing process by inserting 10 seared virgin French oak staves into Cask Strength Maker's and aged for 9 weeks. Hints of wood staves, caramel, and sweetness on the nose, followed by very intense flavors on the palate: a big crescendo of wood blending perfectly with deep, complex and rich notes of vanilla and caramel. Finishes smooth and subtle. 94pf

#### **MAKER'S MARK CASK STRENGTH 12**

Maker's Mark in its purest form. Bottled at barrel proof and non-chill filtered. Big oak and vanilla aromas, with smoky charcoal. Richer, more robust flavors of spice, vanilla, and smoke. Longer finish on front of tongue with no roughness or bitterness. 108-114pf

#### **MAKER'S MARK 101 14**

A personal favorite of founder Bill Samuels, Jr., bottled at a proof that intensified notes of caramel and spice brought on by the higher proof – yet matched with the familiar smoothness. Our first private select barrel, chosen from a specialty finished stave selection. Caramel, toasted marshmallow, and spicy vanilla lead to a lush mouthfeel with spice and light tannin. Chosen to be smooth enough to be sipped neat, expressive enough to enjoy a drop of water or a cube, and assertive enough to pierce through a classically styled cocktail. 109.4pf

#### **MAKER'S MARK WOOD FINISH 2020 SE4 + PR5 20**

The result of two stave profiles (SE4xPR5) – developed in partnership with Independent Stave Company and ultimately utilized together – to achieve the perfect balance of vanilla and caramel. Heavy vanilla aromas with spiced caramel. Tastes of butter pecan ice cream. Vanilla with creamy butter notes, dry spice and caramelized sweetness. Finishes long, round and dry. 110.8pf

#### **MAKER'S MARK WOOD FINISH 2021 FAE-01 19**

FAE stands for Fatty Acid Esters. This is what gives Maker's Mark its subtle notes of dried fruit and signature rich and creamy mouthfeel – characteristics we sought to amplify in the 2021 Wood Finishing Series. Heavy wood, dark fruit, and tobacco. Tastes deep with dried dark fruits, big midpalate with strong tobacco and barrel extractives. Finishes creamy, lingering and round. 110.6pf

#### **MAKER'S MARK 46 CASK STRENGTH 109.6PF 20**

Utilizing the proprietary 46 stave wood-finishing style and bottled at cask strength. Heavy tones of baking spices, mostly cinnamon, and nutmeg, alongside hints of graham cracker and wood tones, dominate the spicy, warming backdrop. 109.6pf

#### **NOAH'S MILL 15**

Lush and rich, with a nose of walnuts, prunes, and floral notes. The palate mimics the nose with walnuts, prunes, spices, intertwined with lavender and balanced with the perfect amount of acid, that leads you down a path of lingering burnt caramel. 114.3pf

#### **OLD ELK BLENDED STRAIGHT BOURBON WHISKEY 14**

High malted barley content in the mash bill of 51% corn, 34% malted barley, and 15% rye. Aromas of sweet vanilla and caramel, clove spice, slight maple, and nutty almond. Tastes of maple syrup, almond, raw bran, chocolate, deep wood, and coconut. Mouthfeel is smooth and coating with a lasting flavor. 88pf

#### **OLD ELK WHEATED BOURBON STRAIGHT WHISKEY 19**

Mash bill consists of 51% corn, 45% wheat and 4% malted barley. Aromas of toffee, vanilla ice cream, caramel and floral notes. Tastes of cream, toffee, vanilla, toasted almonds, and clove. 92pf

Palate leans into some toffee and brown sugar, with hints of cinnamon and smooth charred oak tones. The finish is long and sweet, and gently spicy, with graham cracker and ginger touches. 100pf

#### **OLD FITZGERALD 14 YEAR FALL 2020 40**

Bottled in bond. Nose of wonderfully sweet, toasted oak. Balanced richness, with a long entry point of classic wheat, red fruit, and oak balanced by a soft creaminess. Touches of maple syrup and fig on the finish, peppered with vanilla, green apple, and maltiness. 100pf

#### **OLD FORESTER SIGNATURE 10**

All the Old Forester Bourbons have the same mash bill: Mash bill: 72% Corn, 18% Rye, 10% Malted Barley Strong, sweet coffee aromas laced with chocolate, creamy butterscotch and a hint of licorice. Tastes of ripe apple and other sweet fruit, bakery spice (clove and nutmeg), and toasted oak. Finishes sweet and light, with hints of oak and apple that linger a bit. 100pf

#### **OLD FORESTER 1870 ORIGINAL BATCH 12**

Emulates Old Forester's original batching process by select barrels from three warehouses, each barrel originating from a different day of production, with a different entry proof and a different age profile. The three expressions of Old Forester are then batched together and minimally filtered. Aromas of clove notes spice up a medley of citrus fruits (orange, grapefruit, blood orange), all softened with a delicate, sweet, floral honeysuckle character. On the nose, notes of devil's food, clove and oak spice with an undercurrent of raw vanilla. Buttery leather tastes are quickly dominated by a bold flash of pepper, cinnamon bark and sharp citrus. Intense spice and eucalyptus ending notes which fade into orange cream and caramel. 95pf

#### **OLD FORESTER 1920 PROHIBITION STYLE 16**

On the nose, an intense medley of cherry preserves, drippy caramel, dark chocolate, maple syrup and seasoned oak spiciness. Dark caramel coats layers of malt nuttiness and sweet graham cracker all warmed by green peppercorn and coriander spice brightened with a hint of cedar. Finishes with tart apple crispness gives way to a long smoky finish full of toasted marshmallow, chocolate, and graham cracker sweetness. 115pf

#### **OLD GRAND DAD BONDED 10**

Bottled in Bond. Mash bill: 63% Corn, 27% Rye, 10% Malted Barley. Bottled in Bond. Sweetness begins the front end, with cinnamon spice closely behind. Mash bill 68% corn, 18% wheat, 14% malted barley. Non-chill filtered. Aromas of sherry and traces of caramel and cherry. On the palate, notes of raisin, currant, and cherries, along with hints of almond and vanilla. Finishes light with a touch of dryness. 93pf

#### **RUSSELL'S RESERVE 10 YEAR 12**

Mash bill: 75% Corn, 13% Rye, 12% Malted Barley. Aromas of orange peel and citrus with notes of butterscotch, maple, oak, and vanilla. Rich, spicy caramel, and vanilla flavors. Finishes S=smooth and sweet, with toffee and spice notes lingering with a mild and pleasant warming. 90pf

#### **RUSSELL'S RESERVE SINGLE BARREL 18**

Mash bill: 75% Corn, 13% Rye, 12% Malted Barley. Aromas of vanilla, nuts, and brown sugar with notes of oak and cinnamon. Spicy, bold, and deeply complex with creamy toffee, licorice, and vanilla. Sweet spice and malty notes on the finish. 110pf

#### **STAGG JR. 15<sup>TH</sup> RELEASE 28**

Vanilla bean and salted caramel front and center on the nose, cherries, cinnamon and oak on the palate, and a long finish of toasted vanilla, pepper, coffee and hints of sweet mint. 131.1pf

#### **STAGG JR. 16<sup>TH</sup> RELEASE 26**

Rich, sweet, chocolate and brown sugar flavors mingle in perfect balance with the bold rye spiciness. The boundless finish lingers with hints of cherries, cloves and smokiness. 130.9pf

#### **STELLUM BOURBON 17**

On the nose: clove and allspice, with creamy macadamia nuts and light tobacco. As the whiskey opens up, sweet aromas of honeysuckle, green apple, and nectarine begin to show, rounded off by toasted rye and oak.

#### **WELLER SPECIAL RESERVE 12**

Wheated bourbon. A sweet nose with a presence of caramel. Tasting notes of honey, butterscotch, and a soft woodiness. It's smooth, delicate and calm. Features a smooth finish with a sweet honeysuckle flair. 90pf

#### **WELLER AGED 12 YEARS 22**

Wheated bourbon. Aromas of lanolin, almond, creamed corn and toasty vanilla. The mid-palate flavor is heavily wheated, layered and moderately sweet. Long, oaky, and intensely smooth finish.. 90pf

#### **WELLER SINGLE BARREL 30**

nose of cherry and mint, fading to vanilla. Caramel and baking spices with hints of cocoa explode on the palate, with a finish of cinnamon, coffee, and a hint of pepper. 97pf

#### **WILD TURKEY 101 10**

Mash bill: 75% Corn, 13% Rye, 12% Malted Barley. Blend of 6- and 8-year Bourbons. Aromas of vanilla, along with tastes of that are sweet, bold, and smooth. Finishes with spice and orange peel. 101pf

#### **WILD TURKEY KENTUCKY SPIRIT SINGLE BARREL 15**

Mash bill: 75% Corn, 13% Rye, 12% Malted Barley. Aged for 8 years. Aromas are seductive and complex, with vanilla, almond, and honey tastes. Finish is long and smooth. 101pf

#### **WILD TURKEY RARE BREED 16**

Mash bill: 75% Corn, 13% Rye, 12% Malted Barley. 6-, 8-, and 12-year blend of Bourbons. Rich, balanced caramel with vanilla and honey. Warm, smokey flavors of grain and spice. Finish is long and lingering spice. 112.8pf

#### **WILLET POT STILL RESERVE 13**

Nose is "vanilla lemon cake." The palate is a balance of caramel, vanilla, spices and citrus. 94pf

#### **WOODFORD RESERVE 12**

Nose is heavy with rich dried fruit, hints of mint and oranges covered with a dusting of cocoa. Faint vanilla and tobacco spice. #### **BARRELL GREY LABEL SEA GRASS 38 \* 10z**

The foundation of BCS Gray Label Seagrass began with two groups of 16-year-old 100% Canadian Rye barrels - one with bright citrus and crisp green apple notes and the other with earthy spearmint notes. A portion of the first group was finished in Apricot Brandy casks, a portion of the second group was finished in Martinique rum barrels, and a blend of the first and second groups was finished in Malmsey Madeira barrels. 130.82pf

#### **BARRELL CASK STRENGTH #003 4 YEAR 22**

Blend of rye whiskeys from Indiana, Poland, Tennessee and Canada, all with distinct personalities and varying ages. Started with Tennessee Rye barrels with caramel and dried fruit notes and added the Polish Rye for its nuttiness and mouthfeel. Carefully layered in 13-year Canadian Rye brings out earthy notes of grass, spearmint and apple. The Indiana Rye was the finishing touch to highlight candied fruit and spiciness. 116.7pf

#### **BARRELL SINGLE BARREL 7 YEAR 29**

#### **BARRELL SINGLE BBL 7 YEAR LIQUID INSPIRATION #1 29**

#### **BASIL HAYDEN DARK RYE 14**

Blend of Kentucky Rye and Canadian Rye with a touch of California Port. Oaky aromatic notes balanced with dark berries and molasses. Complex blend of caramel, dried fruit, and oak with back notes of spice and a rounded mouthfeel. Finish lingers with dried fruit with a hint of sweetness and rye spice. 80pf

#### **BASIL HAYDEN 10 YEAR 17**

Aromas of sweet vanilla and oak with a touch of light fruit. The taste is approachable spice and oak notes with hints of caramel. Finishes with tobacco and warm cinnamon heat. 80pf

The bottling lines were completely cleaned beforehand, and no contact was made with non-Kosher spirits. Celebrates the spice of rye, with hints of citrus and clove. Aged for 7 years. 94pf

#### **CORBIN CASH MERCED RYE 15**

Made from an ultra-rare, 100-percent California native Merced Rye mashbill. The whiskey ages in our custom-charred American white oak barrels for up to 6 years. 90pf

#### **CORBIN CASH 1917 MERCED RYE BARREL PROOF 20 123pf**

#### **ELIJAH CRAIG STRAIGHT RYE 10**

Mash bill: 51% rye, 35% corn, & 14% barley. AROMA: Aromas of dark chocolate with spices and a hint of smoke. Rich baking spices on the palate with a smooth oak influence surrounded by honey. The finish is long and lingering. 94pf

#### **HIGH WEST DOUBLE RYE 12**

A blend of straight Rye whiskeys ranging in age from 2 to 9 years. Straight Rye whiskeys: 95% rye, 5% barley malt from MGP 80% Rye, 20% Malted Rye from High West Distillery. Nose has hints of mint, clove, cinnamon, licorice root, pine nuts, and dark chocolate, with a surprising dose of gin botanicals throughout. Rye spices up front palate, then menthol, mint, eucalyptus, herbal tea with wildflower honey and all spice. Finishes with cinnamon and mint, gradually sweetening through the finish, with a hint of anise. 92pf

#### **HIGH WEST RENDEZVOUS RYE 17**

A blend of older Straight Rye whiskeys ranging in age from 4 to 9 years. Non-chill filtered. Straight Rye whiskeys: 95% rye, 5% barley malt from MGP and 80% rye, 20% malted rye from High West  
Nose of poached pear, bitter orange, ground ginger, lavender, wet sandalwood, tanned leather on a well-used wooden work bench. Tastes of persimmon, dried apricot, snickerdoodle, ginger chews, walnut sauce, spiced caramels in a cedar gift box. A finish of cocoa nibs, allspice, toasted oak. 92pf

#### **JACK DANIELS SINGLE BARREL 14**

Mash bill: 70% Rye, 18% Corn, 12% Barley. Complex flavors of ripe fruit mingle with light toasted oak notes to create a taste rich with spice and a pleasant lingering finish. 94pf

#### **JEFFERSON FINISHED IN COGNAC BARRELS 22**

Marries the spice of Rye with the refinement of cognac. Double barreled for at least 9 months and up to 19 months, the Cognac finish adds complexity and depth to the spice of rye whiskey. Nose of cinnamon and honey, with flavors of spice, nutmeg, and citrus. Finish with oranges and honey. 94pf

#### **KENTUCKY OWL #3 10 YEAR AGED 40**

Nose of dark cherry, cocoa, baking spice, and oak tones. Palate continues the dark fruit, along with a touch of dill, citrus, and strawberries. 114pf

#### **KNOB CREEK RYE 12**

On the palate, bold rye spiciness with undertones of vanilla and oak. Aromas of expansive notes of herbs and rye with nuances of oak. 100pf

#### **KNOB CREEK TWICE BARRELED 14**

#### **OLD ELK 23**

A blend of 4, 6, and 8-year Kentucky Straight Rye. Sweet caramel and fruit at the start that gives way to a complex flavor of wood and rye spices. Aromas start sweet with caramel apple up front, followed by rich and complex layers of honey, vanilla, rye grain spice, and charred oak underneath. Mash bill: Believed to be 51% rye, 39% corn, and 10% malted barley. Aromas of clove, vanilla, anise and pepper. Subtle notes of candied spices and citrus. The big finish is smooth with hints of licorice. 90pf.

**SMOOTH AMBLER OLD SCOUT 4 YEAR RYE SNGL BBL 14**  
Aged 4 Years and Non-chill filtered. Nutty, spicy, and with the faintest touch of mint, our Rye is smooth like a bourbon but delivers the direct resonant flavor for which all good ryes are known. Exceptionally drinkable for cask strength. Two versions available: 121.6pf and 117.8pf

#### **STELLUM RYE 16**

Nose of stewed apples, peaches, and pears along with an undertone of baking spices. Nutmeg and clove balance the sweet fruits, while a light mint and licorice note bring further depth to the aroma. On the palate, aniseed, cardamom, and coriander combines with an intense spice punch. Notes of lemon peel and tangerine coming from the rye grain provide a nice citrus component to the overall spiciness. Finishes with star anise, white pepper, and mint before fading into a honey-sweetened jasmine green tea. 116.24pf

#### **WHISTLEPIG PIGGYBACK 6 YEAR 16**

Aged 6 Years. Mash bill: 100% rye. Nose of fresh rye bread, cinnamon, spice, caramel, orchard fruit, grainy and a light bit of bergamot. Slight yeastiness on the palate, followed by butterscotch, cinnamon, raspberry candy, oak, fruit, spice and some citrus. 96.56pf

#### **WHISTLEPIG ROADSTOCK RYE 22**

First ever All-American barrel double finished rye, finished in collaboration with Jordan Winery, utilizing Bordeaux casks, and Firestone Walker Brewery, using Firestone's Imperial Stout, Imperial Blonde Ale and Experimental Ale barrels. Aromas of ripened red berry fruit, with hints of maple syrup and marmalade. On the palate, brown sugar and mocha heightened in the presence of stewed fruit and barrel spice. Finishes with roasted malt, tanned leather, and fresh cracked pepper. 86pf

#### **WHISTLEPIG 10 YEAR 26**

Aged 10 years Aromatics of allspice, orange peel, anise, light oak char and salty caramel. Palate continues the sweetness, with hints of caramel and vanilla, followed by spicy rye mint. Long finish of warm butterscotch and caramel. 100pf

#### **WHISTLEPIG OLD WORLD RYE 12 YEAR 34**

After maturing for over a decade in New American Oak, spirit is divvied into one of three directions. Port pipes (7%), French Sauternes barrels (30%) and Madeira casks (63%) all play a part. Nose of Caramel, vanilla, and winter fruit. Rye spice and apricots on the palate, followed by plums, raisins, dates, and honey. Finishes with dark chocolate, winter fruit, caramel, and vanilla. 86pf

Made from both Scottish and Texas-grown barley. Sweet and indulgent, with aromas of sourdough starter and cream soda, mulled cider, bruised bananas and peaches, tea tree. #### **BARRELL SINGLE BARREL 18 YEAR BARREL No. A133 40**

Barrel#A133. Aged 18 Years. Distilled in Kentucky. 115.6pf

#### **BARRELL 10 YEAR DOVETAIL 5TH RELEASE 22**

Distilled in Indiana and Tennessee, and finished in rum, port wine, and Dunn Vineyards cabernet barrels.

Nose opens with mature aromas both sweet (canelé, panna cotta, crème de noyaux) and savory (walnut oil, leather). An array of fruit follow (smoked apricot, grapefruit peel) as well as from the cask treatment (sloe gin, damson jam). The aroma is high toned, floral and herbaceous, with subtle, balancing pops of minerality. Palate is darker (cocoa, molasses, burnt marshmallow) and spicier (cola, nutmeg, Tellicherry peppercorn) than the nose. #### **BARRELL GREY LABEL WHISKEY 38 \* 10Z**

2<sup>nd</sup> release. The mature, spicy whiskey is front and center, reminiscent of wheat fields edged with wildflowers. There is a rare and noteworthy concentration of aroma, enriched with a candy sweetness and leafy earthiness from the finishing casks, that calls to mind a toasty Belgian waffle.

Begins with two selections of 24-year Canadian whiskey barrels: one set was fruit-forward and tropical, and one was woody, with a light floral aroma. A portion of the fruit-forward blend was transferred into Oloroso Sherry barrels and a portion of the floral and earthy blend was transferred into Armagnac casks. #### **JACK DANIELS SINGLE BARREL 14**

Robust character layers subtle notes of caramel and spice with bright fruit notes and sweet aromatics. 94pf

#### **JACK DANIELS SINGLE BARREL BARREL PROOF 16**

Robust but not overpowering and surprisingly smooth, with the typical Jack vanilla and toasted oak notes with heightened tones of banana bread. 129.3pf

1<sup>st</sup> release in over a century for an age statement of this length. Notes of warm butterscotch and soft fruit, with an incredibly long finish with sweet tobacco and spice. 97pf

#### LITTLE BOOK CHAPTER 4 "LESSONS LEARNED" 30

Blend is made from 4-year Brown Rice Kentucky Bourbon, 7-year Kentucky Straight Bourbon, and 8-year Kentucky Straight Rye Whiskey. Nose is slightly spicy, grassy and herbal. Light notes of cereal grain, light brown sugar green apple support the intensely cinnamon spice-laden sip. 122.8pf

#### LITTLE BOOK CHAPTER 5 "THE INVITATION" 28

Blend : 2-year-old Kentucky Straight Bourbon, 3-Year-Old Malted 100% Rye Whiskey, 5-year-old Kentucky Straight Bourbon, and 15-year-old Kentucky Straight Bourbon. Flavors of caramel and toasted bread, with brown sugar undertones and a touch of sweetness. Creamy mouthfeel with sweet grain flavor, with rye peppery spice and toasted grain/cereal with a hint of nuttiness and a touch of vanilla. Finishes with the heavier barrel flavor from the 15-year. 116.8pf

#### MELLOW CORN

Produced in accordance with a unique set of regulations that define Straight Corn Whiskey. Deep butterscotch and vanilla notes, hints of caramel and dried fruit with a ripened fruit finish. 83.4pf

#### OLD ELK STRAIGHT WHEAT WHISKEY 19

Aged for a minimum of 5 years. Mash bill: 95% soft red winter wheat and 5% malted barley. Lightly honeyed aromas of fruity cherry, vanilla, and oak. Tastes of warm peach, dried fig, vanilla, oak, yeastiness, and cedar. 100pf

#### REDWOOD EMPIRE LOST MONARCH 13

Blend: 60% Rye Whiskey (95% Rye, 5% malted Barley) and 40% Bourbon Whiskey (75% Corn, 21% raw Rye, 4% malted Barley). A blend of 4-to-12-year old Bourbon and 3-to-5-year old Rye Whiskey. Complex nose, with clove, cinnamon, vanilla, orange citrus zest and butterscotch notes, and an intriguing hint of sandalwood. Sweetness on the palate from corn and spiciness from rye combine with an almost maple syrup like flavor. Vanilla and caramel notes lead to a persistent yet subdued peppery finish. 90pf

#### ST. GEORGE BALLER SINGLE MALT 16

"A California take on the Japanese spin on Scotch whisky." 100% American barley, aged in used bourbon casks and French oak wine casks, as well as filtered through maple charcoal. Finished in casks that had held house-made *umeshu* (a Japanese style of plum liqueur made entirely from California-grown ume fruit by St. George). Crisp and dry, with a touch of malt sweetness and a hint of lychee fruit and nutty almond character. The smoky finish lingers and builds with each sip. 97pf

#### UNCLE NEAREST 1884 SMALL BATCH 13

Light-bodied and aged for a minimum of 7 years. Brown butter, with a touch of caramel and vanilla, along with hints of lightly charred oak. Lightly maple finish and vanilla sweetness. 93pf

#### UNCLE NEAREST 1856 16

Blend of aged whiskeys between 8 and 14 years old. On the nose, baled hay and pumpkin seeds with subtle notes of ripe stone fruit and caramel corn. Bold and spicy upfront then mellows with sweet caramel and maple, like biting into an oatmeal raisin cookie. The finish is long and rich. It lingers pleasantly sweet on the palate with notes of vanilla after the spice dissipates. 100pf

#### YELLOW ROSE AMERICAN WHISKEY 11

Light aroma, fruity banana with caramel along with apple pie spice (cinnamon, nutmeg, all spice). Palate is sweet with banana and bright cherries. Medium finish with very little oak on the end. 80pf

### SCOTCH

#### Select Region Overview:

**Highland:** The most assessable entry point for most beginning Scotch drinkers. Typically, low to no peat will be present. Notes of dried fruit, some maltiness, apple tones, and vanilla spice are common. Wide-ranging due to the four subregions present (east, west, north, south) but common attributes include: North a bit more full-bodied, West has a touch more peat, South a bit lighter, softer style, and East continues the lighter style but adds a great fruity component. Note: Speyside falls within the borders of the Highland.

**Lowland:** Only home to five distilleries at this time, but tend to be lighter and very gentle, with little to no peat with only slight touches of salinity due to its more inland location. Grassy and floral flavors abound, with sweet spice notes flowing through the finish.

**Islay:** This island off the west coast represents the smallest region but is vastly known for the abundance of peat and sea-influence. Notes of brine, seaweed, apple, and obviously smoke are the cornerstones. Not for everyone, but a favorite for those who can savor the darker, richer tones.

**Other Islands:** The Isle of Orkney peat is what separates it from the other islands. High sea-influence is still present, but the peat contains more moss and heather due to its location towards the north. The resulting peat is heavily smokey, but is only used in 20% of the mash, with the rest unpeated malted barley. 100% ex-sherry casks are also used, with both American and European oak.

**The Isle of Skye** is home to Talisker, and it is this house-style that reigns supreme. Subtle, understated notes of peat, baking spices, caramel saltiness, and high tones of fruit are apparent throughout the lineup.

#### ABERFELDY 16 YEAR HIGHLAND 28

Matured in a combination of bourbon and sherry casks, this has lovely balance between sweetness and spiciness. Cinnamon and apple pie aspects, with a raisin and caramel touch towards the back. Finishes with a touch of stone fruit and more oak spice.

#### ABERLOUR 16 YEAR SPEYSIDE 24

Rich scented floral and sweet raisin aromas with spicy nuttiness. Smooth and full bodied with sweet, floral and spicy flavors and notes of plum and gentle oak. Finishes long and warm, with spicy fruitiness. Matured for 16 years in a combination of American oak casks and Sherry butts.

#### ABERLOUR 18 YEAR SPEYSIDE 35

Rich and complex aromas of toffee and butterscotch combine with ripe peach and bitter orange. Initial notes of soft apricot and cream are offset by developing flavors of blackcurrant jam and sweet oak with a touch of honey. Finishes very long but balanced and progresses from crème brûlée to a gentle oak flourish.

#### ARDBEG AN OA 17

Aged in several cask types – including sweet Pedro Ximenez; spicy virgin charred oak; and intense ex-bourbon casks, amongst others. The result is a dram with smoky power, mellowed by a delectable, smooth sweetness. Peat, dark chocolate and aniseed are wrapped in smooth, silky butterscotch, black pepper and clove, before rising to an intense crescendo of flavor. 93.2pf

#### BENROMACH 15 YEAR SPEYSIDE 22

Cracked pepper, charred oak, apples, dark chocolate and forest fruits with rich sherry notes and a touch of smoke.

#### BENROMACH 35 YEAR SPEYSIDE 95 \* 10Z

Distilled in the 1980s, in first fill sherry barrels. The nose offers rich sherry influences with orange marmalade, kiwi and grapefruit aromas, complemented by gorgeous cinnamon spice. Sweet on the palate with honey, fruitcake, ripe banana and melon flavors, followed by a smooth white chocolate edge as it develops, combined with a soft menthol note, giving a full body and long and smooth fruity finish.

#### BRUICHLADDICH PORT CHARLOTTE ISLAY BARLEY 21

Zesty lemon, apple sauce and crunchy pears follow an initial sandy sea breeze aromatic note. Floral geranium notes come through with sea pinks and gooseberry, creamy coconut, muddy peat smoke, burnt heather and peach skin, with hints of vanilla and toasted malt. Soft and sweet, texturally there is a thin honey style that slips across the palate. Cask notes intertwine with vanilla, milk chocolate and light cedar and black pepper. Warmed scones and honey from the malt wrapped in earthy smoke and soft apricot. The finish is coconut and peat smoke, mildly iodine-y and hints of almond and geranium. Wonderfully balanced to show the fruity style of the spirit on the nose and the delicate influence of the cask on the palate. The peat smoke weaves its way gently through the whisky highlighting the softer sweeter notes. 2012 vintage. 6 aged years in oak casks, distilled in 2012.

**BRUICHLADDICH 10 YEAR PORT CHARLOTTE HEAVILY PEATED ISLAY 23**

While the smoke is always discernible on the nose it is dry, earthy, peatish with waves of golden caramel, fudge, vanilla custard, hints of ginger, nutmeg, and clove. gentle lemon meringue and clementine. Delicate and soft palate in texture and style. Coconut, vanilla custard, lemon honey combines with smoked oysters and sunbaked salty sand. The finish is sublime, smoky sure, but also soft sweetness of fudge and malted barley, orange, mango and Banoffee pie hinting of the depth and quality of the oak. On the finish, smoke, ripe apple and apricot, beautifully intertwined with malt and oak sweetness and that typical Port Charlotte style dry smoke.

**THE DALMORE 12 YEAR 16**

Aromas of citrus fruits, chocolate, and aromatic spices. On the palate, Seville oranges, dried fruits and hints of vanilla pod. Finishing notes of roasted coffee and dark chocolate. Initially matured in American white oak ex-Bourbon casks, yielding soft vanilla and honey notes. A proportion of the spirit is then finessed in pinnacle Sherry casks, including 30-Year-Old Matusalem Oloroso casks, exclusive to The Dalmore, to give the whisky a rich, nutty character.

**THE DALMORE 15 YEAR 26**

Aromas of orange marmalade, cinnamon and nutmeg. On the palate mandarin, vanilla, ginger and crushed apples. Finishing notes of caramelized orange and rich dark chocolate. Initially matured in American white oak ex-Bourbon casks, yielding soft vanilla and honey notes. It is then finished in multiple rare Sherry casks.

**THE DALMORE 18 YEAR 42**

Aromas of vanilla, dark chocolate, orange and cinnamon. On the palate, dark chocolate, candied citrus fruits, rich coffee, nutmeg and soft licorice. Finishing notes of citrus fruits and rich molasses. Initially matured in American white oak ex-Bourbon casks, yielding soft vanilla and honey notes. For its final maturation: transferred into casks which have held 30-Year Old Matusalem Oloroso Sherry from Gonzalez Byass and give the whisky its rich, deep chocolate character.

**FAMOUS GROUSE BLENDED 10**

Candied fruits, buttery shortbread, citrus peel on the nose. Dried fruit tastes, soft spices (cinnamon/ginger), hint of oak. Finishes smooth and well balanced.

**GLENMORANGIE AGED 10 YEARS HIGHLAND 11**

Known for its mellow tones and delicacy of flavor, welcomes you with a rush of citrus, then holds your attention with layers of luscious flavor, from orange to honey and creamy vanilla, with bursts of peach. 86pf

**GLENLIVET AGED 12 YEARS 17**

Vibrant aromas of summer meadows and tropical fruits, notably pineapple. Floral notes and smooth fruit, fresh peaches, pears and vanilla. Finishes with marzipan and fresh hazelnuts.

**GLENMORANGIE NECTAR d'Or HIGHLAND 18**

Lemon tart aromas with vanilla, lime and orange zest. Sultanas and dates follow, laced with ginger and coconut. Tastes of warming gingerbread gives way to nutmeg and toasted almonds, entwined with meringue and honeycomb. A finish of sweet and mellow, balancing lemon zest, vanilla cream and final traces of ginger and nutmeg. Aged in American oak bourbon casks along with casks that once held Sauternes sweet white wine.

**GLENROTHES SPEYSIDE MASTER'S CUT 20**

Resinous, candied peel aromas with fresh oak notes. Rich, spicy tastes of creamy vanilla and orange peel. Finishes long and fruity, with orange peel notes and a hint of nutmeg. Matured only in first fill sherry seasoned oak casks, bottled at natural color at a strength. Creamy vanilla, orange peel and nutmeg character.

**GORDON & MACPHAIL DISCOVERY 13 YEAR ISLAY 18**

Original Distillery: Caol Ila, aged in Gordon & Macphail casks. Nose is sweet and savory, with dry-cured meats glazed with luscious apricot jam combines with rich vanilla notes. Flashes of softly swirling peat smoke complement the delicious sweetness. Tastes of juicy tropical fruit - pineapple, kiwi, and banana - brushed softly with icing sugar. Light touches of malt and vibrant lemon peel balance the sweetness. Finish with hints of sweet marshmallow toasting over gently smoldering bonfire embers.

**HIGHLAND PARK 12 YEAR ISLE OF ORKNEY 14**

Predominantly aged in sherry seasoned European and American oak casks, boasts warm wintery spices that are engulfed in waves of smoky honey, heather, winter spices, Seville oranges and rich fruitcake and aromatic smoky peat.

**JOHNNIE WALKER BLACK 12**

Scents of rich and tropical dark fruits with hints of sweet vanilla. Depth of flavors developed from maturation in oak casks, combined with creamy toffee notes that come from grain whiskies. Smooth and warming smoke finish. Created using only whiskies aged for a minimum of 12 years from all four corners of Scotland.

**JOHNNIE WALKER BLUE 55**

Wonderfully mellow, rounded nose - replete with dry smokiness artfully mixed with the sweetness of raisins. Serving a velvety combination of vanilla, honey and rose petals - before broadening out to include a zesty orange flavor with notes of hazelnut, sherry and dark chocolate. Signing off with a rich and luxuriously long finish, which showcases Johnnie Walker's trademark smokiness in the most sophisticated way.

**LAGAVULIN ISLAY 16 YEAR 28**

Intensely flavored, peat smoke with iodine and seaweed and a rich, deep sweetness. Dry peat smoke fills the palate with a gentle but strong sweetness, followed by sea and salt with touches of wood. A long, elegant peat-filled finish with lots of salt and seaweed.

#### **LAPHROAIG ISLAY 10 YEAR 16**

The smoke from the unique Islay peat gives Laphroaig its rich flavor. This peated whisky is renowned for its bold, smoky taste, followed by a hint of seaweed and a surprising sweetness. Full-bodied with a long finish. Made from malted barley which is first cold-smoked and then dried over a peat fire.

#### **LAPHROAIG AGED 10 YEARS SHERRY OAK FINISH 22**

Finished in European oak Oloroso sherry barrels. On the nose, sweet and peaty with medicinal notes of Manuka honey, hospital bandages, antiseptic lotion, Germolene, strong cloves aroma but also grilled smoky bacon, a distinctive character of sweet leather, iodine and pine tar. The palate is sweet and aromatic, with rich wax and furniture polish notes followed by treacle toffee, maple syrup, bitter dark chocolate combined with pencil shavings, pine needle and cedar scented wood.

#### **LAPHROAIG AGED 10 YEARS CASK STRENGTH 22**

Batch 012 Bottled Feb 20. Matured in ex-bourbon barrels. Non-chill filtered. Has all the classic flavors of our quintessential Islay Scotch whisky, but more intense. On the nose, sweet cereals with biscuit notes, fresh oak, smoked cedar and Manuka honey. Amsterdam pipe tobacco, shoe polish and old leather combined with a touch of waxy church candle, vanilla cream, nutmeg, and oak extracts. With first sip, sweet and spicy, with burnt oak staves, barbecued marshmallows, toffee and sea salt, vanilla and Belgium caramel waffles. Roasted coffee fudge cream on sticky toffee pudding, with a hint of white pepper and crushed cinnamon. Finishes floral with spicy oak tannins, iodine and sea salt.

Palate Dried fig, spice, and a smoked malt dryness. On the nose, fresh oranges, lemons, and pears, with a hint of salt and peat. Finishes long, smooth, and oaky sweet with a grain of salt.

#### **SPEYBURN SPEYSIDE 15 YEAR 16**

Hints of rich dark chocolate on the nose, with spicy notes of raisins, zesty citrus fruits and vanilla. On the palate there are notes of oranges, toffee, vanilla and leather, all wrapped together with a gentle spice. The long-lasting finish has a warming spice which is sweet and creamy.

Fifteen years maturing in American oak and Spanish oak casks have allowed this bold whisky to embrace the rich, natural elements of Speyside.

#### **TULLIBARDINE THE MURRAY HIGHLAND 18**

Distilled in 2005, bottled in 2017. Matured in first fill American oak cask and bottled at cask strength. Notes of Vanilla ice cream mingle with syrupy pineapple and bursts of sherbet lemon. The sweeter flavors are interwoven with hints of malted biscuit and honey, which culminate in a smooth, lingering finish.

### IRISH WHISKEY

#### **BLUE SPOT 7 YEAR CASK STRENGTH 25**

Matured for no less than 7 years in Bourbon casks, Sherry butts and Portuguese Madeira casks all bottled at cask strength for you to enjoy! Nose A light mix of pineapple, kiwi, green banana and lime zest followed by Pot Still spices, baked apple, hazelnut and toasted wood. Taste A smooth mouthfeel with a subtle mix of fruit, a hint of clove oil and cracked black pepper corns. Sweet spices, vanilla and cinnamon add to the wood's nutty contribution. Finish A lasting and distinctly palatable balance of exotic fruits and spices.

#### **GREEN SPOT SINGLE POT STILL 15**

A non-age statement Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey comprising of pot still whiskeys aged between 7 & 10 years. The whiskey has matured in a combination of new bourbon and refill bourbon casks as well as sherry casks. Fresh aromatic oils and spices with orchard fruits and barley on a background of toasted wood. Full spicy body. A hint of cloves along with the fruity sweetness of green apples, rounded off with toasted oak. Followed by lingering flavors of spices and barley.

#### **GREEN SPOT CHATEAU MONTELENA ZINFANDEL 22**

Crisp oak combines with the soft sweetness of vanilla, white chocolate and marshmallow, balanced with signature Green Spot red apples and ripe pears, along with pomegranate, cranberries and maraschino cherries, the contribution of the wine cask. Sweet mouth coating takes on a dry note thanks to the effect of the wine cask. Pot still spices subside with zesty citrus leading to ripe orchard fruit and red berries. A touch of marzipan and toasted oak add to the complexity.

Initially matured in traditional sherry and bourbon casks, then finished for 12 months in French oak Zinfandel wine casks from the prestigious Chateau Montelena in Napa Valley, California.

#### **GREEN SPOT CHATEAU LEOVILLE BARTON BORDEAUX 22**

The French oak drives the initial aroma with crisp woodland notes added to the spicy Pot Still character. The wine seasoning brings a floral perfume and ripe berries to the archetypal orchard fruits.

The familiar mouth coating is a very satisfying balance of oak and spices. Some vanilla sweetness works in harmony with the dry orchard fruits and French oak, combining effortlessly with barley grains to complete the complexity. For the finish, the rich French oak slowly fades leaving the wine & the spices of France & Ireland with the last word.

Initially matured in traditional sherry and bourbon casks, then finished in French oak wine casks from the renowned Château Léoville Barton, Bordeaux.

#### **THE IRISHMAN FOUNDER'S RESERVE 10**

A blend of two styles, single malt and single pot still, and completely from a copper pot still and 0% Grain or Column still. 80pf

#### **THE IRISHMAN SINGLE MALT 16**

Triple distilled in both American Oak Bourbon and Oloroso Sherry. Dark caramel, spiced cake, candied fruit and dark fig, with a honeyed touch Long, warm finish with a slight maltiness and sundried raisins.

#### **JAMESON 10**

Smooth and mellow aromas, with a balance of spicy, nutty and vanilla notes with hints of sweet sherry and exceptional smoothness.

#### **KILBEGGAN 10**

On the nose, sweet caramel, vanilla and toasted wood aromas. Delicate malt and clean grain become more apparent with time. On the palate, soft almond nougat, peach, caramel, and vanilla flavors before finishing quickly with soft, light malt sugar flavors. Dryness persists alongside the finish with some genuine woody oak tones. Aged in ex-bourbon casks for a minimum of four years.

#### **KILBEGGAN SINGLE GRAIN 14**

Aromas of coconut cream, vanilla, jellied fruit and summer red berries. Wafer-like biscuit sweetness on the palate, with hazelnut and light spice with nice oak tannins drying on the side of the mouth. Finishes crisp and fruity, with glazed cherries drying with a lingering spice.

The notion that "single grain" describes a whiskey made with just one grain is a common misperception. Rather, the term refers to whiskey made in a single location using malted barley and at least one other grain. 94% of the mash bill is made of meticulously-sourced corn, with the other 6% being malted barley.

#### **METHOD & MADNESS SINGLE GRAIN MATURED IN BOURBON, FINISHED IN VIRGIN SPANISH OAK 15**

Aromatics of new pencil shavings, light rose petal, and fresh rain on pine. Tastes of warm toasted oak, fresh peeled grapefruit, and zesty wood spices. Finish of sweet cereal, clove spiciness, and fresh mint.

#### **METHOD & MADNESS SINGLE POT STILL MATURED IN SHERRY & BOURBON, FINISHED IN CHESTNUT OAK 17**

Nose of red licorice laces, fresh rosemary and mint, and grated ginger root. Tastes of sweet fruit and spice, cinnamon toast, and ripe banana. Finishes with aromas of green tea, dissipating fruit and spice, and a rich wood farewell.

#### **METHOD & MADNESS SINGLE MALT MATURED IN BOURBON, FINISHED IN FRENCH OAK CASKS 20**

Nose of freshly shelled peanut, cereal malt aroma. Taste of cracked cinnamon stick, and ice cream cone wafer. Finish of fragrant bon bons, and a hint of toasted barley.

#### MIDDLETON BARRY CROCKETT LEGACY 50

Elegant aroma of vanilla and toasted oak complimented by a touch of lime, succulent green berries, pears, and green sweet pepper. Light pepper carries onto fresh citrus, limes, and mandarin orange sweetness. A hint of cinnamon with vanilla and oak reveals its years spent in American oak. The full spectrum of flavors lasts well into the finish.

Bearing the name of the celebrated second generation Middleton Master Distiller, this represents a selection of pot still whiskeys which have been matured exclusively in American bourbon barrels with a subtle contribution from a pot still distillate which has matured in an unseasoned American barrel.

#### REDBREAST SINGLE POT STILL 12 YEAR 14

A complex spicy and fruity aroma with toasted wood notes evident. Full flavored and complex; silky smooth with a harmonious balance of spicy, fruity, sherry and toasted notes. Finish is satisfyingly long; the complex flavors linger on the palate. Matured in a combination of Bourbon seasoned American Oak barrels and Oloro so Sherry seasoned Spanish oak butts.

#### RED SPOT SINGLE POT STILL AGED 15 YEARS 30

Pot Still spices with rich cooked fruit, baked apple, mango and black cherry. Hazelnut and a touch of new leather fuse with toasted American Oak. A mix of ripe fruit sweetness from the Marsala seasoned wine casks. While the fruit remains, sweet red pepper and cracked black pepper add some spiciness, finished by notes of American Oak and barley. An extra-long infusion of fruits and spices.

Matured for over 15 years in a combination of American Bourbon casks, Spanish sherry butts and Sicilian Marsala wine casks, all contributing in rich and complex flavors, making it the top spot in the range.

#### WRITERS TEARS COPPER POT 13

A unique marriage of Aged Single Pot Still and Single Malt Irish whiskey. Distilled entirely from barley, both malted and unmalted. Non-peated and matured in American Oak bourbon casks. On the nose, flashes of apple with hints of vanilla. Gently spiced, ginger & orchard fruits tastes. Finishes long & elegant with dark chocolate.

#### YELLOW SPOT SINGLE POT STILL AGED 12 YEARS 25

Mown hay & cracked black pepper. Red bell peppers, nutmeg, clove oil & green tea. Sweet honey & peaches from the Malaga casks. Honey sweetness with pot still spices. Flavors of fresh coffee, creamy milk chocolate & Crème Brûlée. Notes of red apples & toasted oak. Its finish is sophisticated & complex with a sweetness throughout, followed by a mix of red grape & dry barley upon exit.

While Green Spot is often described as tasting like green apples, Yellow Spot is more in character with juicy red apples. Sophisticated and complex in character, the inclusion of full term matured whiskey from ex Malaga casks contributes exotic notes.

### MEXICAN WHISKY

#### ABASOLO ALMA DE LA TIERRA 12

Deep, nuanced notes of roasted corn, honey, vanilla, black tea, and leather, revealed through nixtamalization, are unlike any other whisky profile.

Crafted and distilled from 100% Mexican Cacahuazintle (kaka · wha · SINT · lay) corn, which has been cultivated and passed down for more than 200 generations by local farmers for its distinct, extraordinary flavor.

### CANADIAN WHISKEY

#### CROWN ROYAL 10

Rich and robust aromas, with slight hints of vanilla and fruit. Delicately smooth and creamy with hints of oak and the sweet flavor of vanilla. Long and lingering finish.

#### PENDLETON 11

Vanilla, honey, butterscotch, and custard join together for a pleasing aroma. Hint of freshly grated cinnamon bark. Warm fall fruits and honey are balanced with a hint of spice to balance the flavor. A medium balance and smooth finish.

### TAIWANESE WHISKY

#### KAVALAN EX-BOURBON OAK SINGLE MALT 28

clean and fresh tropical fruitiness with lingering vanilla, coconut and spices.

#### KAVALAN SHERRY CASK SINGLE MALT 35

clean and complex with multiple layers of dried fruit, nuttiness and spices, it has some marzipan and vanilla touches to it.

#### IWAI MARS 13

Blend of 70% corn and 30% malted barley. Aged between 2–5 years in ex-bourbon barrels. Delicate nose of cinnamon and brûléed sugar; palate of Red Delicious apple skin and English breakfast tea with pleasant tannin on the finish. 80pf

#### IWAI 45 MARS 15

Blended Japanese Whisky produced at Mars Shinshu in Nagano Blend of 70% corn and 30% malted barley. Aged between 2–5 years in ex-bourbon barrels. A nose of chocolate-covered shortbread precedes a palate of brown sugar and ripe pear with confident structure; a whisper of red fruit appears on the finish. 90pf

#### IWAI MARS TRADITION 17

Blend of 70% malted barley and 30% corn. Aged 3–12 years with an average age of 5 years. Aged primarily in ex-bourbon and ex-sherry casks; wine, port and new oak may be incorporated for consistency across the range. The nose introduces clove and wildflower honey with just a hint of peat before transitioning to nougat and milk chocolate on the palate; cinnamon gracefully joins this restrained chocolate note on the finish. 80pf

#### HIBIKI HARMONY 18

Nose of rose, lychee, hint of rosemary, mature woodiness, sandalwood on the nose, with honey like sweetness, candied orange peel, white chocolate flavors. subtle, tender long finish, with hint of mizunara. 86pf

#### HIBIKI HARMONY 2021 LIMITED EDITION 22

Nose of rose, lychee, hint of rosemary, mature woodiness, sandalwood. On the palate, honey-like sweetness, candied orange peel, white chocolate. Finishes subtle, with a tender long finish, and a touch of Mizunara (Japanese oak). 86pf

#### HIBIKI 17 YEARS OLD 45

aromas of peach, apricot, melon, rose, lily, lemon leaf. on the palate, notes of toffee, black cherry, vanilla, and mizunara (japanese oak). finishes with a sweet, fruity, with lychee aftertaste.

#### HIBIKI 21 YEARS OLD 75 \* 10z

A calming influence is immediately present. nose of cooked fruit, blackberry, ripe banana, caramel. Tastes of sandalwood, honeycomb, dried apricot and mizunara. Finish long, rich with incense aroma.

#### KIKORI THE WOODSMAN 12

Distilled in Japan and made from 100% locally grown rice. Barrel aged for a minimum of three years in american oak, french limousine oak, and sherry casks. Floral and fragment aromas, with a velvety smoothness on the palate.

#### NIKKA DAYS 14

A delicate balance of mellow grain whiskies and slightly peated malts. floral aromas, silky mouthfeel and fruity flavors that rise and expand, leaving behind a delightful aftertaste. 80pf

#### NIKKA COFFEY GRAIN 20

Predominately made from corn, whisky distilled in a Coffey still is matured in old casks such as re-filled, remade and re-charred casks originally made from American oak. 45% abv  
The Coffey still is the world's first patented continuous still invented by Aeneas Coffey in 1830. While Masataka Taketsuru was staying in Scotland, he had an opportunity to learn how to distill grain whisky in a Coffey still firsthand from craftsmen at James Calder in Bo'ness in 1919. These traditional Coffey stills are not easy to operate and not efficient to obtain spirits. However, they retain flavors originating from ingredients and deliver a distinctive creamy texture.

#### NIKKA COFFEY MALT 23

Made from 100% malted barley, whisky distilled in a Coffey still is matured in old casks to enhance the rich maltiness, complexity and a silky texture. This expression is not categorized as "malt whisky" but as "grain whisky" since it is not distilled in a pot still. 90pf

#### NIKKA WHISKY FROM THE BARREL 21

blended from more than 100 different batches of malt and grain whiskies. after blending, the whisky is filled into used barrels and matured for another few months. This "marriage" process harmonizes all components in the formula, resulting in a mellow taste. 102.8pf

#### NIKKA TAKETSURU PURE MALT (WHITE LABEL) 20

This is an expression launched in 2020, with a refined formula and a new label design to represent the brand. While remaining a smooth and well-balanced blended malt, the formula further showcases an exquisite balance between elegant softness and deep complexity along with rich mouthfeel and smokiness. 43% abv

This is a signature label in honor of Nikka's founder Masataka Taketsuru, the first Japanese who mastered whisky-making in Scotland and brought this expertise back to Japan. A "pure malt" is a blend of malt whiskies from various distilleries, whereas a "single malt" is a whisky made exclusively from one distillery. A "pure malt" is also known as a "blended malt".

**NIKKA TAKETSURU PURE MALT (BLACK LABEL) 24**  
Original formula before changing with the white label. The luxe aroma mixes rich butterscotch and apple sweetness. On the palate, this whisky is light and gentle, interspersing fruit and smoke and finishing with a spark of cinnamon heat.  
43% abv

**NIKKA MIYAGIKYO SINGLE MALT 22**  
this bottling has estery aromas generated by carefully selected yeast strains along with distinctive Sherry cask influence. Nikka's founder Masataka Taketsuru chose a valley in the Miyagi prefecture as the site for his second distillery. He aimed to make a complete contrast between the two distilleries, Miyagikyo and Yoichi, with different natural environments and production methods. Started in 1969.

Miyagikyo malts are described as elegant and fruity. Made from light peated and non-peated malted barley, whiskies distilled in pot stills heated by indirect steam express a signature fruitiness and delicate mouthfeel. 90pf

**NIKKA MIYAGIKYO SINGLE MALT PEATED 40\* 10Z**  
This limited edition of Miyagikyo single malt was introduced in 2021 as the first of the "Nikka Discovery" series. In anticipation of Nikka Whisky's 90th Anniversary, the series offers an inside look at the various experiments in the whisky-making process that Nikka has practiced over the years. This expression is crafted solely from batches of peated malt, offering a significant distinction from the "light and fruity" image of Miyagikyo. It showcases the exquisite combination of bold, distinctively peaty notes, while leaving its signature estery hint in the aftertaste. 96pf

**NIKKA YOICHI SINGLE MALT 22**  
vatting various different malt whiskies together, this bottling expresses a delicate balance between peaty, smoky and fruity aromas. Yoichi Single Malt is a range of single malt expressions from the Yoichi Distillery, Nikka's first distillery built in 1934. The founder Masataka Taketsuru chose the town of Yoichi in Hokkaido because of the similar environmental conditions to Scotland, where he learned whisky-making.

Yoichi malts are described as bold and strong with refined peaty notes and smokiness brought by the traditional direct coal-fired distillation. Sea breeze from the Ishikari Bay delivers a briny hint to the whisky during maturation. 90pf

**MARTIN MILLER WESTBOURNE 13**

Built for cocktails, with an old-school emphasis on more spice and less citrus. Intense and citrus. An emphasis on the spicier, peppery notes of cassia and nutmeg. Intense citrus peels aromas integrated with juniper and a very smooth alcohol balance. Subtle sweetness from liquorice enhances the citrus presence. 90.4pf

**MARTIN MILLER 9 MOONS 25**

Cask-aged for 9 months in American oak bourbon barrels in Iceland. On the nose, lemon peels in the first impression integrated with juniper, with balanced vanilla afterwards. Slight sweetness on the palate with a creamy feeling. Extremely long finish with notes of oak. 80pf

**MG MEZCAL GIN 17**

gin made with the cenizo mezcal maguey, and produced like pechuga with botanicals like ancho chile, hibiscus flower, avocado leaves, and lemongrass instead of a chicken breast.

**MONKEY 47 14**

47 total botanicals, including cubeb pepper, cassia bark, coriander, grains of paradise, musk seed, allspice, cardamom, cloves, nutmeg, and licorice, along with angelica root, acacia, bramble, lingonberries, spruce, amongst others.

There is also a touch of apples, a fruit deeply related to the history of Nikka, followed by pleasantly tangy hints of green Japanese Sansho pepper on the finish. 47% abv

Impeccably clean and easily mixable, Singani 63 is a Bolivian spirit with a rich history that is distilled high in the Andes from Muscat of Alexandria grapes.

#### ST. GEORGE BASIL EAU-DE-VIE 11

Using brandy as the base spirit gives the palate richness without distracting from the basil. fresh genovese basil gives body and flavor, while fresh thai basil lends spice and top notes. on the palate, you'll find a warm, sweet, fresh, vegetal, and slightly menthol character. On the nose: bright anise

## **VODKA**

### **ABSOLUT ELYX 12**

made from winter wheat grown on one single estate in southern Sweden. Clean, rich, rounded, fresh bread and notes of white chocolate and light cereal and with a deep mellow spice. Full bodied, luscious silky mouthfeel with waves of rich macadamia nuts, creamed cereal and garnishes of white chocolate and buttery notes of freshly baked bread. Light fresh nuttiness with a well-balanced hint of mellow spice and pure balanced richness. Rounded mellow spice with fresh nuttiness and a well-balanced warm smooth finish.

### **AMASS COPENHAGEN 12**

Citrus and warm lemon drop candy turn to hay and sweet tea, before fading to frost and cold iron. Bitter lemon first, then grassy notes of dry summer and iced tea. More hay and wild flowers, and then finally cereal and a grainy sweetness. Organic Wheat Spirit, Organic Marigold Petals, Organic Chamomile Flowers, Organic Lemon Zest, Organic Cane Sugar.

### **BELUGA NOBLE RUSSIAN 12**

Clean and crisp with a little bit of grain flavour. Perfect for drinking straight, as is the Russian way, Made with barley malt spirit, and is very lightly flavored with honey and extracts of oat and milk thistle.

### **BELUGA RUSSIAN ALLURE 14**

Clean and minerally with mild white pepper and faint bread notes. Very faint dill and aniseed. Silky mouthfeel with muscular black pepper spice. Faint nutty maple syrup with slightly salty note. Very clean, with black pepper spiced finish fading with toasted nutty and vanilla notes. Small amounts of maple syrup and fig extract are added to the vodka to add a touch of extra sweetness and added roundness.

### **BELVEDERE 12**

Made from only Polska rye, purified water and a distillation process by fire, Belvedere contains zero additives, is certified kosher.

Nose is Soft and inviting, with notes of vanilla and cream. Full and round with medium body and a naturally smooth, rich and velvety texture. Light vanilla notes sway between sweet and savory, with a hint of black pepper and spice. Sustained finish with notes of almond, clotted cream and faint Brazil nut characteristics.

**BELVEDERE SINGLE ESTATE RYE LAKE BARTEZEK 14**  
Bright, fragrant with notes of freshly cut rye grain, grass and a hint of almond. Medium-bodied and delicate with notes of spearmint, fresh hay and a hint of biscuit. Finishes clean and crisp with notes of menthol, fresh grass and rye bread.

Crafted with rare Diamond Dankowskie Rye from a single estate located on the shores of Lake Bartezek in Poland's Masurian Lake District, this fresh, smooth and delicate vodka reflects the unique terroir of its estate. Snowy, cold winters stress the rye and develop the vodka's delicate, refined character – more reminiscent of the region's calm lakes than its harsh climate.

**BELVEDERE SINGLE ESTATE RYE SMOGORY FOREST 14**  
Intense aromas of sea air, toasted rye bread and caramel. Rich and mellow with initial impressions of salted caramel, cereal and a touch of honey. Persistent with delicate notes of toasted bread, white pepper and fudge. Mouthfeel is rich, well rounded and luscious. Finish is long and salty/sweet. Notes of baked bread, sea salt and caramel.

Subtle green apple and vanilla nose. Creamy and earthy taste. Full bodied mouth-feel. Long, clean finish, no burn

### **CHOPIN RYE 12**

Subtle aromas of rye bread. Vibrant pepper flavor. Medium body. Short, crisp finish.

### **CHOPIN WHEAT 12**

Floral bouquet aroma. Sweet with notes of caramel. Light mouth-feel. Gentle and pleasant finish.

### **CHOPIN SINGLE YOUNG POTATO 2015 VINTAGE 25**

Spicy and herbaceous, with a slight tropical fruit touch towards the end. Unlike most vodkas, this is distilled just once to retain its unique flavor and character.

### **CHOPIN SINGLE RYE 2012 VINTAGE 25**

Golden Dankowski Rye is carefully harvested from farms in Mazovia, Poland. This Rye has been hand selected and processed to retain its natural flavors in the 2012 Rye. Unlike most vodkas, this is distilled just once in order to retain its unique flavor and character.

### **CHOPIN SINGLE WHEAT 25**

Lovely delicate aromas of anise, citrus and orange blossoms with a silky, off-dry medium body and a smooth, grain, wax, powdered sugar and mineral accented finish. Unlike most vodkas, this is distilled just once in order to retain its unique flavor and character.

### **CHOPIN FAMILY RESERVE 30**

On the nose, hints of spice that accent a gentle, sweet musk. Palate opens with a delicate earthy sweetness. Followed by understated notes of licorice and clove. Finish is medium-long with a lingering warmth. Features a special variety of young potato that was planted during the 2016 growing season in the rich, dark soil of the estate fields surrounding the distillery. The potatoes were harvested when they were still young, producing a sweeter tasting profile with delicate earthy notes. The spirit was then left undisturbed in fifty-year-old Polish oak barrels for two years to allow time for it to rest and mellow before being bottled, by hand.

#### **CORBIN CASH SWEET POTATO VODKA 10**

Made from 100-percent-estate-grown California sweet potatoes, water from the farms' natural aquifers, and filtered slowly through their carbon blend, made in a fashion that produces hints of sweetness and a buttery smooth texture. 80pf

#### **DOUBLE CROSS 11**

Subtle and quiet aromas with hints of citrus and white chocolate. Silky and creamy palate. Balances with bright flavors of white pepper and lemon zest.

Round, smooth texture that's as delicious straight as it is mixed. A warm, medium-long finish leaves you with a dry, clean palate. Estate grown winter wheat from Slovakia.

#### **GREY GOOSE 12**

Delicate & Floral nose, with a sweet and round palate. Finishes bold with toffee notes. Made from French soft winter wheat.

#### **GREY GOOSE VX 19**

Notes of white fruit blossom, honeysuckle and violets, with cognac from the premier cru region of Grande Champagne which brings delicate essence of orchard fruits, plum, apricot and the mild flavors of wild honey.

#### **HAKU 11**

Nose of soft aroma played up by the sweet, delicate floral aroma of rice. Palate is a rich taste that gradually envelops the mouth with the natural sweetness and complex flavor of the rice. A smooth finish with a sophisticated, pleasantly lingering sweetness thanks to the bamboo charcoal filtration process.

#### **HANGAR ONE BUDDHA'S HAND CITRON 12**

The ancient relative of the modern lemon, Buddha's Hand Citron has a lower acidity that allows complex flavors and aromas to come through. Additional tastes of jasmine, basil, and apricot.

#### **JCB CAVIAR-INFUSED 20**

Made from sustainably grown grapes from the Côte-d'Or, infused with French Caviar. The Pinot Noir grapes are barrel aged for 6 months, while the Chardonnay grapes, also hand-picked and sorted, are gently pressed to release the natural golden juice, then fermented and aged in French oak barrels for 6 months.

#### **JCB TRUFFLE-INFUSED 20**

Similar makeup to the Caviar-infused JCB, but this time infused with the famous black truffle of Périgord.

#### **KETEL ONE 13**

Hints of citrus and honey with a crisp, lively tingle. Silky softness leads into a long finish with subtle flavors.

#### **NIKKA COFFEY 12**

corn and barley are separately distilled, blended, and refined with white birch charcoal. zesty notes, rich sweetness and milky mouthfeel perfectly captures the exquisite fullness brought by the coffey stills. 40% abv

#### **ST. GEORGE CITRUS 12**

astonishingly clear citrus flavor, genuinely tasting of both sour and sweet orange. redolent of the whole citrus plant, with focus on the bright peel characteristics. tart almost lemony scent in the nose. made from real California-grown Valencia oranges, Seville oranges, and bergamot.

#### **ST. GEORGE GREEN CHILE 12**

made from a variety of California-grown hot and sweet peppers (jalapenos, serranos, habaneros, red and yellow bell peppers) that build layers of sweet, savory heat. Lime peel and fresh cilantro add even more vibrancy and depth of flavor.

#### **STOLICHNAYA 11**

Made from wheat and rye grain. Marshmallow, mineral and mild fruit peel aromas, a soft, supple entry leads to a smooth, medium bodied palate with pastry frosting, talc and citrus rind flavors. It finishes with a clean, lightly sweet, sugar dust, wet straw and balanced pepper fade.

#### **TITO'S 11**

Distilled from corn. Sweet corn is obviously apparent from the start, but with an added note of white pepper. Creamy, slightly sweet mouthfeel aided by a scent of cracked black pepper and just a touch of grain.

#### **WHEATLEY 10**

#### **WODKA 10**

Polish rye, distilled five times. A bit of bay leaf, cracked peppercorn, with a crisp, light body. Peppery finish.



## SPIRITS

### THE MAGUEYS OF MEZCAL

#### ESPADIN

The Espadín agave, known as the genetic Mother of the Blue Weber Agave, is used to produce tequila, and is also the predominant agave used in mezcal production. Unique in itself, the characteristics of this agave showcase the aromas of wet earth, a rich smokiness on the mid-palate, and a finish reminiscent of wild flowers. This variety of agave is a subspecies of the Angustifolia Family of agave.

#### BARRIL

This thick-foiled, wild agave, often used as fencing to divide land in Oaxaca, intensifies the complexity of this mezcal. As citrus and floral notes arise, hints of green peppers compliment the nose. The palate is a delightful balance of citrus and creamy banana. Barril is a subspecies of the Karwinskii Family of agave.

#### MEXICANO

The Mexicano agave thrives in the moist environment of lower elevations. This wild agave can grow quite large and is usually harvested when close to ten years of age. The concentration of sugar in the fully mature agave produces an extremely powerful mezcal. The palate is distinctively herbaceous and earthy with a long lasting finish in the mouth. Mexicano is subspecies of the Rhodacantha Family of agave

#### CUISHE

One of the most physically distinct species of agave, the Cuishe, a subspecies of the Karwinskii Family of agave, grows vertically as a single stalk with its leaves spreading at the top. Due to its unusual structure, and the stalk containing the firmer piña material, the Cuishe can be difficult to harvest and to work with in general. This agave offers aromas full of tropical fruit with a dry piney and mineral finish.

#### CENIZO

Of the Durangensis family of agaves, this wild agave is typically harvested from the hillsides of Durango. Cenizo thrives in high altitudes up to 8,500ft with cool and dry conditions.

#### ARROQUENO

Magüey arroqueño (*Agave americana var. oaxacensis*) is a massive wild Magüey that can take upwards of 20 years to mature. It is the genetic mother of Magüey espadin, which is the most commonly used Magüey in Mezcal. Many in the Mezcal industry are concerned that this wild Magüey will become more and more rare as Mezcal's popularity rises, because of the extensive time required for these Magüeyes to grow.

#### MADRECUISHE

Madrecuishe is part of the Karwinskii family of agaves. It thrives in dry climates and typically grows in a tall, cylindrical shape. Due to the agave's dense core and low water content, mezcal made from Madrecuishe typically has high minerality with vegetal and floral notes.

#### TEPEZTATE

The Tepezate, a subspecies of the Marmorata Family of agave, has a very distinct, erratic leaf structure and flourishes best on the sides of steep, rocky cliffs. The Tepezate produces beautiful quotes at the end of life which flower a rich yellow before turning to seed. This agave offers a powerful, unique aroma dominated by floral characteristics. tobalá A small agave varietal, the Tobalá, a subspecies of the Potatorum Family of agave, has broad, spade-like leaves. The compact size of this agave yields limited quantities of mezcal and takes 12-15 years to reach full maturation. At this time, the plant sends up a flower-bearing spike that can be anywhere from 10 to 20 feet high. Known to many as the king agave, Tobalá can only grow from seed and is becoming increasingly rare. This agave offers intensely aromatic mezcal with complex notes of tropical fruit.

#### MANSO SAHUAYO

Produced from an unspecified scientific agave grown in the Jiquilpan and Sahuayo region. Locally it is also known as "Cenizo", due to the color of the leaves, but the CRM recognizes it as Manso Sahuayo.

#### COYOTE

Part of the American Oaxacensis agave family, the Coyote is particularly hard to find in the wild. Sourced from Villa Sola de Vega in Oaxaca, this agave is typically characterized by its herbaceous and earthy aromatics with a spicy finish. chino verde Chino Verde is a wild, extremely rare agave foraged from the Sierra Madre del Sur mountains. This agave can grow quite large and is usually harvested between seven and nine years of age. The concentration of sugar in the fully mature agave produces an extremely powerful mezcal.

#### TOBASICHE

A subspecies of the Karwinskii Family of agave, the Tobasiche is a wild agave that needs twelve to thirteen years to fully mature. This agave is typically characterized by its herbaceous and cedar-like aromatics with an earthy finish.

#### MASPARILLO

Found in the lower areas of El Mezquital, Durango. Wild and scarce, this small magüey has very short and wide leaves, with a yellowish-green color. It has a 1.5 to 2 m. diameter and 1 m. height, delivering piñas that weighs 70 kg. on average. 14-16 years old.

Jabali (*A. convallis*) is a notoriously challenging plant with which to work. At every step of the production process after the roasting the plant will foam due to a high quantity of a chemical compound that naturally occurs in agave

### **CASTILLA**

Part of the American Oaxacensis agave family, the Castilla is a close cousin to the Espadín agave. Smaller in size than an Espadín and often discovered more in the wild, this agave is heavily influenced by its terroir. Sourced from deep in the heart of the Oaxaca valley close to a river, the agave added fruit forward notes.

### **PAPALOTE**

The Cupreata agave, known as maguey Papalote in the state of Guerrero, grows wild on the mountain slopes of the Rio Balsas basin. The harvesting of this agave is extremely difficult due to the altitude of the steep slopes where it is found. Cupreata from Guerrero presents a profile starting with sweet floral notes, followed by the aroma of wet earth and subtle minerality, reminiscent of an approaching storm. Cupreata is a subspecies of Papalote.

### **SACATORO**

A subspecies of the Angustifolia family, the Sacatoro agave takes about eight to twelve years to mature and is harvested from the hillsides of Guerrero. Unique in itself, the characteristics of this agave showcase the aromas of wet earth, a rich smokiness on the mid-palate, and a finish reminiscent of wild flowers.

### **MEZCAL**

#### **BOZAL ENSAMBLE 13**

Magüey: Espadín, Barril, Mexicano  
Slightly smoky, yet herbaceous undertones rest on the center of the palate, while citrus and floral notes from the Barril are introduced and strengthened by the warm viscose finish of the Mexicano. This is a light and easy sipping mezcal, which will delight and surprise you with its complex lingering finish.

#### **BOZAL CENIZO 17**

Magüey: Cenizo  
Opens with bright aromas of orange peel and floral notes. The palate is driven by big flavors of mesquite and sweet barbecued meats. Hints of dark chocolate and cocoa complement the slight smokiness on a smooth and long finish.

#### **BOZAL CUISHE 17**

Magüey: Cuishe  
Driven by intense citrus and strong minerality, the Cuishe has a dry entry. As is experienced in the rich tropical fruit on the palate that moves to sweet potato on the front. Green vegetal notes in the mouth and a dry smoky finish then follow. A complex flavor profile that proves quite enjoyable.

#### **BOZAL MADRECUISHE 17**

Magüey: Madrecuishe  
The nose is complex with aromas of ripe jalepeño, cocoa and floral notes. A smooth palate introduces earthy flavors of beet and sweet potato, complemented by a sweet minerality and hints of pollen. Green vegetal notes and a slight capsicum spice linger on the finish.

#### **BOZAL TEPEZTATE 17**

Magüey: Tepezate  
Herbaceous aromas, with a touch of wet stone on the nose, accompanied by grapefruit zest, orange flower and pine. Fresh florals, white pepper and minerals are highlighted on the palate with prominent notes of spice on the finish.

#### **BOZAL TOBASICHE 17**

Magüey: Tobasiche  
With an unconventional sweet nose this mezcal exerts traces of quince, anise, and strong minerality. This bouquet is complimented by rich herbaceous botanicals on the finish.

#### **BOZAL JABALI RESERVA 25**

Magüey: Jabali  
The aromatics express notes of lavender and sage. Bright green vegetal flavors of celery and parsley grace the palate with a lingering finish of black pepper. In keeping with the 200-year-old tradition, the agave hearts are cooked in earthen pit ovens, later to be crushed and mashed by hand.

#### **BOZAL SACATORO RESERVA 25**

Magüey: Sacatoro  
Slight sweetness on the nose with a soft mineral scent of river rock. An initially viscous mouthfeel leads to a savory palate with flavors of sage, fennel and creamed corn. The finish is lasting with a brined salinity and effervescence.

#### **BOZAL TOBALA RESERVA 25**

Magüey: Tobala  
With an unconventional sweet nose this mezcal exerts traces of quince, anise, and strong minerality. This bouquet is complimented by rich herbaceous botanicals on the finish. In keeping with the 200-year-old tradition, the agave hearts are cooked in earthen pit ovens, later to be crushed and mashed by a stone tahona wheel turned by a horse.

#### **BOZAL GUIAS CALABAZA SACRIFICIO 25**

Magüey: Espadín  
Crushed by a stone tahona wheel moved by a bull, baked in earthen pit ovens, fermented and then distilled. During the second distillation, pumpkin stems, in addition to seasonal fruits and grains harvested from the local market, are suspended inside the bottom of the still in a basket. Local produce includes pineapple, plantains and oranges, along with pumpkin seeds and chepiche.

A unique, vegetarian Sacrificio offering, the nose provides bright scents of citrus peel and orange blossom, complemented by herbal notes of mint and eucalyptus. The chepiche used in the final distillation shows through on the palate, rounding out warm vegetal flavors imparted by the pumpkin stems and plantains. Enjoy with charred bell pepper and grilled sweet potato fajitas.

**MEZCAL (CONT.)**

**BOZAL BORREGO SACRIFICIO 25**

Maguey: Espadin, Tobala

Crushed by a stone tahona wheel moved by a bull, baked in earthen pit ovens, fermented and then distilled. During the second distillation, a leg of lamb, in addition to seasonal wild fruits and grains harvested from the local market, are suspended inside the bottom of the still in a basket. Wild fruits include strawberries, apples and pineapple, while additional ingredients consist of pecans and ginger.

A dry mineral base is offset nicely with an abundance of fruit, herbaceous notes and nuttiness. A viscous entry coats the mouth leading to a fruit forward mid palate with subtle sweetness that shines with bright citrus and persimmons. The finish is smooth with flavors of smoked lamb.

**BOZAL IBERICO SACRIFICIO 25**

Maguey: Espadin, Mexicano, Tobasiche

An age-old tradition from mezcaleros, Jamón Ibérico is typically produced in small batches for personal consumption as a ceremonial and festive mezcal, taking place at year-end. First, the agave is crushed, baked in earthen-oven pits, fermented and then distilled in a copper pot still. Organic cooked and seasoned pork shoulder with locally sourced aromatic herbs, spices, and seasonal fruits are added into the second and final distillation.

The Jamón Ibérico expresses a citrus-forward nose of lime and grapefruit with a tropical aroma of banana. A viscous mouthfeel coats the palate with savory flavors, complemented by a slight floral note of hibiscus flower

**BOZAL PECHUGA SACRIFICIO 26**

Maguey: Papalote

The Pechuga expresses a delicate balance in which the smokiness is softened noticeably by the protein and wild fruit. A rich mouthfeel offers flavors of roasted fruit, subtle minerality and a slight smokiness, finishing dry on the back of the palate. 93.8pf

**BOZAL BARILL RESERVA 27**

Maguey: Barill

The aromatics are herbaceous and spicy with notes of forest grass and anise flower. A slight sweetness is evident on the unctuous palate with flavors of agave, honey and river stone, finishing with a floral aftertaste. 94pf

**BOZAL CASTILLA RESERVA 27**

Maguey: Castilla

Driven by the region that the Castilla was sourced from, the aromatics are fruit forward and earthy. A slight sweetness is evident on the palate with flavors of roasted agave, mocha and fresh mint and pepper, finishing smooth with subtle hints of smoke. 94.6pf

**BOZAL COYOTE RESERVA 27**

Maguey: Coyote

A stunning expression of the unique character of the Coyote agave. An earthy and slightly smoky entry leads to a mid palate that is driven by flavors of minerality and rich dark chocolate. Finishes dry and balanced, indeed an enjoyable mezcal crafted for sipping.

**BOZAL CHINO VERDE 28**

Maguey: Mexicano Chino Verde

The Chino Verde mezcal offers aromas of earth, dried herbs and burlap with a soft smokiness. Ancho chile coats the palate, accompanied by flavors of charred meats and slight sweetness with a viscous finish.

**BURRITO FIESTERO ARTESANAL 13**

Maguey: Cenizo

Light and elegant smokiness, with a touch of sweetness and predominant floral notes. Lightly vegetal, with a hint of cotija and butter.

**BURRITO FIESTERO ARTESANAL ENSAMBLE 16**

Maguey: Cenizo & Verde

A blend of Agave Cenizo (durangensis) and Agave Verde (cassispina). Well-rounded body with sweet and spicy notes finishing with a smooth smokey and intense aftertaste. 92pf

**BURRITO FIESTERO ANCESTRAL MASPARILLO 27**

Maguey: Masparillo

Touch of gingerbread and oatmeal cookie on the nose, along with cherry cola and citrus. Baked pineapple, a light but elegant smoke surrounds the flavors of vanilla and wet grass before giving way to a pronounced minerality.

**BURRITO FIESTERO ANCESTRAL CASTILLA 35**

Maguey: Castilla

Found on the lower areas of El Mezquital, Durango, Wild and scares, this huge maguey has very long and narrow leaves, with a green color. It has a 2 to 3.5m diameter and 1.5 to 2m height, delivering piñas that weigh 120kg in average. 100.4pf

**CLASE AZUL DURANGO 44 \* 10z**

Maguey: Cenizo

Aromas of citrus and herbal, green olive, cooked agave, and cloves. Plate is defined by the flavors of peanut, brown sugar, honey, wood, chocolate, and notes of ripe fruit.

**CONVITE ARTESANAL COYOTE 35**

Maguey: Coyote

A rare mezcal with an unmatched sensorial experience. The palate has a burst of white pepper, floral notes, and a touch of fresh herbs that lingers throughout the finish.

**DEL MAGUEY VIDA 10**

Maguey: Espadin

Vida has an aromatic nose of tropical fruit with hint of honey, and tastes of ginger, cinnamon, and a bit of tangerine, with a long, smooth finish.

**DEL MAGUEY CREMA DE MEZCAL 11**

Maguey: Espadin & Meil de Maguey

A combination of Miel de Maguey (unfermented syrup of the roast agave) and Mezcal San Luis del Rio – double distilled from 100% mature agave Espadin, produced the original, natural 400-year-old, hand-crafted way. Crema de Mezcal has a nose of roast maguey, with vanilla and pear, a creamy almond, apple, coffee, pineapple palate and a long sweet smoky orange finish.

**DEL MAGUEY VIDA DE MUERTOS 15**

Maguey: Espadin

A special 45 ABV edition of Vida inspired by the batches of Mezcal that are distilled in autumn by the family of Paciano Cruz Nolasco and shared for the celebration of Dia de los Muertos. Traditionally hand crafted from 100% mature agave Espadin. Aromatic nose of tropical fruit and hints of warming spice, a creamy texture with floral notes, green herbs and poblano peppers, with a long, complex finish.

**DEL MAGUEY SAN LUIS DEL RIO 18**

Maguey: Espadin

San Luis Del Rio has a spicy, fruity and smoky nose with a high note of citrus. It is creamy, smooth and warming to the palate with a clean finish.

**DEL MAGUEY SANTO DOMINGO ALBARRADAS 20**

Maguey: Espadin

Albarradas has a high light nose with lots of citrus overtones. A bit of roasted pear too. Lots of tropical fruit on the tongue, spicy and woody with a clean dry finish.

**DEL MAGUEY CHICHICAPA 20**

Maguey: Espadin

Chichicapa has a medium nose and a complex taste with lots of citrus and a long, smooth finish with overtones of mint. The pueblo elevation is 5,052 ft. in a broad valley with a desert and tropical micro-climate.

**DEL MAGUEY MINERO 22**

Maguey: Espadin

This Minero from Santa Catarina Minas has a nose full of flower essence, vanilla and figs with a burnt honey flavor and a bit of lemon. Minero is deep and warm, sweet all the way to the finish.

**DEL MAGUEY LAS MILPAS 22**

Maguey: Espadin

Offers a nose of slate and minerals, balanced by tropical fruit and citrus notes, with rose petal florals, lavender, tarragon, and pea shoots, that evolves into a long and pleasantly dry finish.

**DEL MAGUEY SAN LUIS DEL RIO AZUL 27**

Maguey: Azul

Earth-roasted, fermented with airborne microbes, twice distilled, unblended the original, centuries-old Oaxacan, hand-crafted way. Possesses a distinctively creamy mouth feel with bright citrus notes and dried tropical fruit (banana chip). A sweet green herbaceous, wet stone quality appears with a touch of white peppercorn and a medium long finish.

**DEL MAGUEY ARROQUEÑO 30**

Maguey: Arroqueño

This Special Edition of 360 bottles made from giant semi-wild, maguey Arroqueño is dedicated to Thor Heyerdahl, Biologist, Explorer and Great Human Being. Arroqueño has notes of luscious melon on the palate, like cantaloupe and a bit of baking chocolate in the background. It is very vegetal, reminiscent of fresh green beans, with savory medium to long finish.

**DEL MAGUEY MADRECUIXE 30**

Maguey: Madrecuixe

Banana leaf, green papaya, just-mown alfalfa, tarragon and fresh cut bamboo, give way to circus peanuts and sweet, fresh-forward tropical fruits of mango, pineapple and chicozapote. This extremely rare wild mezcal is silky, elegant, medium-bodied, with a long, dry, clean, dusty finish.

**DEL MAGUEY SAN JOSE RIO MINAS 30**

Maguey: Espadin

A bright sweet nose of papaya and ripe peaches gives way to a lightly sweet and very floral palate like carrying a bouquet of roses and violets. Rio Minas palate ends with pepper notes and an herbal component of Hoja Santa and eucalyptus resulting in a refreshing finish.

**DEL MAGUEY SAN PABLO AMEYALTEPEC 30**

Maguey: Papalote (Cupreata), Pizorra

Nose of spice and lilacs, palate of sweet tropical fruit, crisp citrus and pear skin, with a creamy, complex mineral finish. Limited edition bottling.

**DEL MAGUEY TOBALA 30**

Maguey: Tobala

Sweet, fruity nose, with a mango and cinnamon taste and long, extra smooth finish. The Tobala maguey is found growing naturally only in the highest altitude canyons in the shade of oak trees like truffles.

**DEL MAGUEY WILD JABALI 30**

Maguey: Jabali

On the nose, offers notes of fresh figs, baked apples, star anise and a hint of parmesan rind. On the palate there is bright, beautiful acidity with high florals of sweet violets, herbal notes of tarragon and a slight sandalwood finish.

**DEL MAGUEY WILD TEPEXTATE 30**

Maguey: Tepextate

Offers a lighter body with a bright candied fruit nose of banana taffy and spun sugar. The sweetness carries into the palate with notes of passion fruit and marzipan. A light cinnamon note of canela (organic Mexican sugar) lies in the background with floral notes of honeysuckle

**DEL MAGUEY PECHUGA 38 \* 10Z**

Maguey: Espadin

Pechuga begins with Minerero mezcal that has already been double distilled. In preparation for a third distillation, they place about 100 liters of mezcal in the still and add about 100 kilos of wild mountain apples and plums, big red plantain bananas, pineapples, a handful of almonds and a few pounds of uncooked white rice. Next, a whole chicken breast (pechuga), skin removed, bone structure complete, is washed in running water for about three hours to remove any grease. This is then suspended by strings and a 24 hour, third distillation is begun. The vapor passes over the pechuga and condenses into a crystal clear liquid that has an amazing taste and smoothness. Upon completion the pechuga is removed from the still and hung in the family Altar room...the most important space in the house.

**DEL MAGUEY IBERICO 42 \* 10Z**

Maguey: Espadin

A unique mezcal made with Ibérico de Bellota ham in collaboration with Chef José Andrés. The legendary ham made of free-range, acorn-fed, black-footed Ibérico pigs from Spain.

The result is a wonderful marriage of flavors and aromas and an innovative expression of pure mezcal. has a spicy floral nose of carnation, tropical aromatics of gardenia and jasmine, ripe pear, dark fig, notes of wet green hay and forest floor. It enters the mouth like a caramel, and is round, soft and gentle, full-bodied, with a big middle palate. The long finish tastes of roasted root vegetables and umami, leaving the mouth with terracotta, a slate-like minerality and a touch of salinity.

**DON MATEO DE LA SIERRA ALTO 25**

Maguey: Inaequidens (Alto)

The nose of this mezcal is ripe with agave, pine, and citrus with an herbaceous underbelly. The mouthfeel is big and coats the entire mouth. For taste, it has strong citrus fruit and deep earthy notes that mingle through a long smokey finish.

**DON MATEO MANSO DE SAHUAYO 22**

Maguey: Manso de Sahuayo (Cenizo)

produced using Agave Americana var. Manso de Sahuayo (formerly known as Cenizo). This agave is endemic to the municipality of Sahuayo, Michoacan. Mezcalero Emilio Veyra works with local farmers there to source the best agaves possible. The harvested agaves are roasted in a pit oven, fermented in wooden tanks. The still is a pine and oyamel (fir) Filipino style alembique still. Heads, tails, and natural spring water are used for alcohol adjustments.

**EL SILENCIO 10**

Maguey: Espadin

Very soft in the mouth with sweet ripe fruits dominating the palate and a backbone of subtle and intermingled smoke and spice.

**KOCH EL MEZCAL ARTESANAL ENSAMBLE 16**

Maguey: Espadin and Madrecuishe

Aromatics: Their aromas begin introvert, as if they were ashamed of showing themselves. Slowly, you will find transporting yourself little by little to an altar full of wet flowers of cempasuchil, sugarcane and piloncillo, which reflects the sugary juice of the agave after being extracting from the grinding. It smells like yesteryear magazines with that smell of cardboard and old newspaper that seems to carry lustrums on its back, it smells like old closet, chile piquín, hot stones. On the palate: Is citric, slightly smoky, floral, it goes well on the mid-palate. Elegant and interesting ending.

**KOCH EL MEZCAL ARTESANAL GUELAVILA 13**

Maguey: Espadin

On the palate: Persistent cooked pineapple flavor with notes of coconut, roses and freshly cut herbs. On the medium palate, ripe peach, and cinnamon, with hints of white pepper and a fine flavor of sherry gelatin at the end.

**KOCH EL MEZCAL ARTESANAL TEPEZTATE 19**

Maguey: Tepezate

Aromatics: Subtle and calming vegetal aroma and fresh herbal notes with delicate hints of wood, sawdust, resin and pine tree. On the palate: Notes of Jalapeño pepper and citric fruits. Wet stones, herbaceous and black pepper nuances on the mid-palate. Gentle smoky grilled meat in the background, and medium persistence.

**KOCH EL MEZCAL ANCESTRAL ARROQUENO 19**

Maguey: Arroqueno

At the beginning, aromas of wood ash with hints of citrus, herbaceous, and river stones, which soon give way to aromas of roast meat, with a light smoke and long persistence. At the end it leaves an itch of ginger and tangerine peel. On the palate: Medium bodied, with sweet attributes, caramel coffee flavors, and a fruity finish with hints of white grapes, orange, ripe pineapple and quince.

**KOCH EL MEZCAL ANCESTRAL COYOTE 23**

Maguey: Coyote

It has a round mouth feel and herbal flavor notes with hints of light fruit tones. It is both sweet and spicy.

**KOCH EL MEZCAL ANCESTRAL JAYACATLAN 24**

Maguey: Espadin

Aromatics: Long persistence of orange blossom and cinnamon, with touches of old leather and smoky cedar. On the palate: Medium-bodied with mineral notes and light touches of chai tea. A silky texture with candy cotton flavor and a long finish of almond butter.

#### KOCH EL MEZCAL ANCESTRAL TOBALA 24

Maguery: Tobala

The finish is herbal with hints of oregano, basil and a slight accent of roasted pineapple. On the palate: A combination of banana, melon, applesauce with nutmeg, burnt sugar and a touch of sweet wood smoke. Frugal notes of creamy yogurt at the end.

Maguery: Bruto (also known as Alto)

Aromas of leather, tobacco, blueberries, soil  
Flavors of sweet agave, bitter roots

#### LA LUNA MEZCAL CHINO SILVESTRE 23

Maguery: Chino (wild Cupreata)

Aromas of lemon, evergreen forest, pine, resin. Flavors of slightly savory, cooked agave, anise

#### LA LUNA MEZCAL CUPREATA 13

Maguery: Cupreata

Aromas of clean, floral nose with hints of citrus blossom and vanilla. Flavors citrus notes, smooth textures, and a deft touch of wood smoke

#### LA LUNA MEZCAL ENSAMBLE 24

Maguery: Chino & Manso Sahuayo

Aromas of sweet roasted agave, roasted pineapple, orange zest, grassy. Flavors of sweet agave, sweet mint, savory spices.

This mezcal is spicy up front and moves quickly to tropical fruits, ginger, and roasted peppers.

#### LOS VECINOS DEL CAMPO TOBALA 24

Maguery: Tobala

It has earthy aromas with floral undertones and notes of citrus zest on the nose. Tasting notes include a sweetness followed by tropical fruits like mango and apple, with a spiced finish.

#### MADRE MEZCAL 11

Maguery: Espadin

A single varietal exploration that allows the full spectrum flavor of Espadin agave to shine through. 80pf

#### MADRE ENSAMBLE 13

Maguery: Espadin and Cuishe

A blend of two types of agave unlocks natural flavors often hidden behind the smoke. 90pf

#### MEZCAL VERDE MOMENTO 10

Maguery: Espadin

Notes of grass, soft smoke, and fresh peach.

#### MONTELOBOS ARTESANAL 14

Maguery: Espadin

Nose of earth, freshly cut grass, honey, citrus, asparagus, and smoke. Balanced taste between cooked and green maguery, with nuts, herbacity, and smoke. 86.4pf

#### SIEMBRA METL DON MATEO MICHOCAN 21

Maguery: Cupreata

Rich with forest floor aspects, such as pine needles and moss, alongside a smokey-sweet nose of rich, herbaceous agave and wet earth. Hints of resinous pine bark leads to a finish of fresh cut agaves and meadow.

#### SEÑOR SOTOL ARTESANAL ENSAMBLE 12

Texanum, Cedrosanum, Wheeleri

Distillate from the dasylirion wheeleri shrub

Smoked cacao, sweet tobacco, vanilla hints with a pepper finish. Smooth sweetness with a funky aftertaste.

#### SOTOL POR SIEMBRE 12

The nose opens with bright citrus and white flowers quickly growing herbal and vegetal with an intense note of damp, freshly turned earth and whispers of wood smoke and black pepper. On the palate, black pepper spice, earth, mineral, wet stone, rich and chewy texture with a long, dry and mildly smoky finish.

**TEQUILA**

**Plata or Silver:** often stainless steel aged, for no more than 60 days. Cleanest, purest expression of blue weber agave. Can occasionally be “rested” in used oak barrels.

**Reposado:** rests in used boubon or american oak, for a minimum of 2 months and a maximum of one year.

**Añejo:** aged between one to three years, intensifying the color and refreshing the flavors gained from oak aging.

**Extra Añejo:** aged past three years, producing the richest, creamiest style that often showcases abundant vanilla and caramel qualities while maintaining the spicy components.

**Cristalino:** aged tequila that has been filtered (typically through charcoal) to remove oak notes and wood flavors while retaining the soft, mellow note that occur through aging.

Blend of plata and 8 year extra añejo, further finished in pedro ximenz sherry barrels. Notes of hazelnut, dried chamomile flowers, candied orange peel, wood, walnut, vanilla and raisin aromas on the nose and flavors of oak, ginger, green olives, chocolate, salted caramel, fig and a subtle hint of smoke.

**CLASE AZUL ULTRA 170 \* 1oz**

Extra añejo. finished for 5 years in sherry casks. Sherry, prune, apricot, and cherry aromas, with hints of maple honey, hazelnut, and intense oak notes. Flavors of prune, cinnamon, caramel cream, vanilla, and crystallized ginger.

**ARTENOM 1549 ORGANICO BLANCO 14**

At 6,788 feet above sea level in the remote mountain town of Jesús María, Felipe Camarena masterfully crafts from stressed hillside agave plants grown in tequila’s highest-altitude agave region. slowly roasted in brick ovens and macerated intact with their fibers for a richer, fuller flavor. On the nose, rising pastry dough, spring rain, mint, bold roasted agave. velvety, wine-like texture with fresh chile tingle, white pepper, spearmint candies

**CASA DEL SOL BLANCO 15**

smooth and complex body, with pleasant hints of fresh agave, mint and warmed by notes of spice and caramel green apple.

**CASAMIGOS BLANCO 14**

Hints of citrus & sweet agave on the nose, with a fruit forward profile of vanilla and grapefruit. Rested for 2 months in stainless steel.

**BLANCO (CONT.)**

**CHINACO BLANCO 11**

lovely bouquet of pear, quince, dill and lime, tinged with aloe. It's very clean, smooth, fresh and bright on the palate, with exceptional depth and balance, followed by a smooth, long, lingering finish.

**CINCORO BLANCO 18**

Slightly sweet aromas of fresh and cooked agave, light vanilla. Smooth and complex, with fresh and cooked agave, citrus (lime, grapefruit), light vanilla flavors. Fresh agave, citrus, light vanilla, pepper on the finish. Blend of both highland and lowland Jalisco Blue Weber agave.

**EL TESORO BLANCO 16**

Aromas of fresh agave mixed with honey and a touch of green olive. Sweet taste balanced with agave, white pepper and subtle green notes. Finished slightly subtly sweet with hints of white pepper.

**CLASE AZUL PLATA 25**

Bright, crisp, and refreshing. Light to medium bodied, with fresh aromas of orange, lemon, and mint. Hints of vanilla, green apple, and green tea  
Vanilla, Meyer lemon, fresh mint, and a touch of green guava on the finish.

**CORAZON EXPRESIONES BLANCO 18**

aromas of cooked agave, herbal, citrus, aniseed and notes of green apple. Plate notes sweet, soft, mint, eucalyptus and slightly tangy.  
Aging 60 days in stainless steel – with less aging, terroir is expressed in the tequila.

**DON FULANO BLANCO FUERTE 18**

Profoundly aromatic with floral glimmers of jasmin and orange blossom. Aromas of yellow apple and cooked, mature agave round out this expression and make it soft and smooth despite its higher proof. 100pf

**FORTALEZA BLANCO 13**

Aromas of citrus, and rich cooked agave, with a touch of butter, olive, earth, black pepper, and a deep inviting vegetal complexity. Flavors include citrus, cooked agave, vanilla, basil, olive, and lime.

**FORTALEZA BLANCO STILL STRENGTH 15**

Aromas of fruit, baked fully-ripened agave, green olive, and earth are present. Slightly brighter and a touch more rustic than the regular blanco, the accents of butter, olive, earth, black pepper, and vegetal qualities in the flavor are enhanced because it comes straight from our small copper pot still, without adding water prior to bottling.

Aged 8 months in French Oak

#### ARTENOM SELECCION de 1414 REPOSADO 14

Grown at 5,400' in municipio of Arandas, Jalisco. Aromas of vegetal chapparal, roasted sweet potato. Flavors of salted vanilla cookie, allspice, mild chile heat.

#### CASA DEL SOL REPOSADO 18

Rests for a minimum of four months in Select French Oak and Cognac barrels handcrafted with French Limousin Oak. The woody aroma evokes soft vanilla with hints of raisin and sweet tobacco. To taste, it has notes of wild honey, raisin, and butterscotch.

#### CASAMIGOS REPOSADO 14

caramel aromas with hints of cocoa. notes of dried fruits and spicy oak with a touch of sweet agave. aged 7 months in premium American white oak barrels.

#### CINCORO REPOSADO 23

Aromatics of cooked agave, with hints of vanilla, baking spices, toasted creme brûlée. Smooth, slightly sweet, light oak. Cooked agave, caramelized vanilla, white chocolate. Aged 6-8 months in American Oak. Fresh aromas of thyme, green grass, and agave nectar mingle to create a vibrant nose on this reposado. Earthy tones play an integral role on the palate with support from soft vanilla, marcona almond, and fresh herb flavors. Round on the palate and refined.

**FORTALEZA REPOSADO 15**

Aromas of citrus, caramel, butter, cooked agave, and sage. Flavors include cooked agave, citrus, vanilla, apple, earth, and cinnamon. Aged in used American oak.

**HERRADURA REPOSADO 13**

aged for 11 months in charred American white oak. rich amber color with notes of cooked agave, vanilla and butter. smooth, sweet finish with a slight taste of spice.

**SIETE LEGUAS REPOSADO 17**

Scents of cooked and raw agave, light herbal and citrus notes infused with the fresh essence of ripe fruit, similar to the fragrances present in silver tequila. Followed by gentle vanilla, very light touches of nuts, dried fruit, raisins and prunes, sweet flowery fragrances and woody notes from the barrels.

**TEPOZAN REPOSADO 13**

aged up to 6 months in Kentucky white oak bourbon barrels

**TEREMANA REPOSADO 14**

Notes of oak and vanilla with a smooth, rich finish. aged in former bourbon barrels from 2 months up to a year

**TERRALTA REPOSADO 15**

aged 6 months in white oak whiskey barrels from Kentucky

**TRES GENERACIONES REPOSADO 13**

Rested in American oak barrels for at least 4 months. Aromas of pepper, spice and herbs in balance with light oak character. Smooth, round and slightly sweet. Initial spiciness, with toasted oak, on a background of herbs and fresh agave. Finishes warm and dry with lingering white pepper.

**PASOTE REPOSADO 16**

Lusciously supple and warming, this agave tequila is rich with softly mellowed flavors, thanks to barrel aging in American oak. The fruit-forward taste of roasted agave melds with fresh floral notes and subtle hints of sweet vanilla. 80pf

**PUEBLO VIEJO REPOSADO 10**

Distinct aromas of floral citric blossoms, caramel, butter and ripened fruits. The palate confirms the aromas of butter and ripe fruit; pepper and cinnamon flavors make it slightly specious and fruity.

**ADICTIVO AÑEJO 18**

Aged for 2 years in French oak, with aromas of dried fruits and toasted oak. Long, silky texture on the palate.

**ARTE NOM SELECCION de 1146 AÑEJO 18**

Aged in Cabernet Franc wine barrels from the Loire Valley 60% of the tequila is aged for two years, 40% is aged for three years. The two maturations are then slowly integrated together, before laying into toasted American white oak previously used to age Tennessee rye whiskey.

An elegant blend of Añejo and Extra Añejo aged in French Oak and XO Cognac barrels. Notes of honey, toffee, butterscotch, and dried fruit marry to create soft and balanced tequila.

**CINCORO AÑEJO 32**

Aromas of oak, sweet, cooked agave, maple, orange rind Palate is complex, with toasted oak, cooked agave, butterscotch, dark chocolate. Finishes elegant, evolving over time. Cooked agave, dried fruits, baking spices. Aged in ex-bourbon barrels for 24-28 months.

**CLASE AZUL AÑEJO 63 \* 10z**

25 months in bourbon barrels produced rich depths. Toffee, cinnamon, cloves, toasted hazelnut, vanilla, orange marmalade, quince, and toasted oak lift the aromatics, followed by high tones of nutmeg, cloves, orange marmalade, and toasted oak that finishes with a silky sensation.

**CORAZON EXPRESIONES T. H. HANDY AÑEJO 27**

beautifully complex but well-balanced. charred wood, caramel, almond, clove, nut and cooked agave are present on the nose. Smooth and lightly sweet, this añejo has a dense texture with a soft, harmonious finish. Aging 19 months in Thomas H. Handy Bourbon barrels.

**DON JULIO 1942 AÑEJO 30**

Two and a half years in used american barrels, with aromas of rich caramel and chocolate. Warm oak, vanilla, and roasted agave flavors. Finish of lingering oak and rich vanilla.

**FORTALEZA AÑEJO 20**

18 months in American oak, 100% stone crushed. Caramel, vanilla, butterscotch and cooked agave aromas, with hints of pineapple, peach, orange blossom, nutmeg, and raisin in the nose. Butterscotch, caramel, toffee, citrus, and hazelnuts.

**GRAN CENTENARIO AÑEJO 15**

Aged in new American oak. Aromatic notes of toasted oak, chocolate, caramel, and nuts. Soft and complex with a slightly sweet taste and a balanced profile.

aged over 44 months

**CORAZON EXTRA AÑEJO 20**  
Aromas of earthy roasted pineapple greens blend with sweet vanilla on the inviting nose. Ultra-smooth taste with flavors of oak, tropical fruit and spice melding together to create a sophisticated finish. Aged at least 36 months in American Oak.

**CORRALEJO 1821 EXTRA AÑEJO 30**  
aged over 36 months

**EL TESORO EXTRA AÑEJO 22**  
aged in American oak for 4-5 years

**EL TESORO PARADISO EXTRA AÑEJO 28**  
Aged 5 years in ex-cognac barrels. Aromas are a mix of butterscotch and herbs, with soft hints of smoke, oak and tropical notes. On the palate, a blend of sweet butterscotch and herbs, and finishes with hints of smoke and oak.

marries tequila with an average age of four years with reserves aged up to 15 years

**LUNAZUL AÑEJO EXTRA AGED ELIJAH CRAIG BARREL 13**  
aged for 46 months in elijah craig bourbon whiskey barrels

**PASOTE EXTRA ANEJO 40**

**SAN MATIAS GRAN RESERVA EXTRA AÑEJO 15**  
aged at least 3 years in white oak barrels

**TERRALTA EXTRA AÑEJO 24**  
extracted using the tahona method, aged at least 4 years in ex-bourbon barrels

**HERRADURA ULTRA AÑEJO 16**  
an anejo filtered to remove color and enhance smoothness, with a hint of pure agave nectar added back. Notes of vanilla, wood, and caramel on the nose, along with cooked agave, honey, dried fruits, and toasted almonds.

**JOSE CUERVO REPOSADO CRISTALINO 13**  
Matured in American White Oak and blended with Tradicional Añejo and Reserva De La Familia Extra Añejo for added complexity. Notes of agave, tropical fruit & subtle hints of oak, and flavors of vanilla and spice with a hint of melon

**TRES GENERACIONES AÑEJO CRISTALANO 14**  
100% blue weber agave which is triple-distilled for extra smoothness. rested in American white oak barrels for at least 12 months to add an array of subtle flavors and a smoky finish. Finally, this aged liquid is rock filtered to gently extract the color, rounding out the flavor profile.



## SPIRITS

### CACHAÇA

#### LEBLON 11

sugarcane spirit from Brazil. aged in used Cognac casks between 30 days and 3 months to add smoothness to the fruit-forward tone that is light and pure.

#### NOVO FOGO SILVER 11

The purest representation of organic sugarcane from Southern Brazil, this silver cachaça proves that terroir matters. The aroma of bananas immediately present, followed by pleasantly floral rainforest notes that shine through the spirit. Sea salt balances the cachaça's tropicality, adding a savory quality and settling the overall impression to a mouth-watering sweet red pepper. This cachaça is rested in chemically-inert stainless steel tanks for one year to smoothen it without changing its flavor.

#### NOVO FOGO CHAMELEON 12

"Chameleon" expression marries the savory identity of the Silver Cachaça with the vanilla notes of the oak-kissed Barrel-Aged edition. aged for one year in repurposed American oak barrels, just long enough to reach mixability peaks without losing its rainforest and sugarcane funk. a hazelnut nose is continued with sweet and spicy herbs in the palate and finished with lively citrus. From tiki drinks to stirred aperitifs, this versatile cachaça is the bartender's friend.

#### NOVO FOGO BARREL-AGED 12

Aged organic cachaça distillate in 53-gallon American oak bourbon barrels that have been taken apart, sanded, and re-toasted. The 2-3 year process takes place in the heat and humidity of our home in the Atlantic Rainforest. Banana bread, with notes of chocolate, cinnamon bark, and coffee. Nuances of pepper remain, but the cachaça's time spent in wood changes its spiciness from fresh red pepper to toasty black pepper.

#### NOVO FOGO COLIBRI 12

To mature the Colibri expression ("hummingbird" in Portuguese), we moved the cachaça back and forth over the years between repurposed American oak barrels and amburana (Brazilian teak) barrels. The predominant spices of vanilla and toffee (from the oak) and cinnamon and chestnuts (from the teak) come together in a balanced expression that also includes tropical fruit such as banana and passionfruit but finishes playfully with notes of snickerdoodle.

#### NOVO FOGO GRACIOSA 12

This expression is aged for 2 years in repurposed oak and finished for 18 months in castanheira do Pará (Brazil nut) barrels, lending it a vibrantly aromatic yet creamy disposition: starting with pecan and orchids on the nose, the palate morphs into cherry custard and finishes with pleasant notes of soft clove and anise.

#### NOVO FOGO TANAGER 13

"Tanager" expression mixes the Brazilian South's two favorite woods. We age this cachaça in repurposed oak barrels and finish it in casks of arariba (Brazilian zebrawood) for a natural red color and a distinctive mountain earthiness. This truly unique cachaça suggests tropical fruit, grass, cinnamon bark, and other holiday spices; it can be sipped alone or as the base spirit in twists of classic cocktails like the Sazerac.

### PISCO

#### BARSOL PISCO PRIMERO QUEBRANTA 10

distilled from fresh wine made of 100% quebranta grapes from the Southern Valley of Ica, Peru. Aromas of pear, red apples, fresh cut grass complimented with dry fruit and pastry notes, fresh cream and cacao, balanced with delicate citrus notes. tastes of ripe pear, red apples, red grape, citrus notes, roasted almond, walnuts and pecan, dark chocolate, cereal, dried apricot and ripe dark berry fruit. Finishes round, elegant, long.

#### BARSOL PISCO ACHOLADO 12

Blend of three types of Pisco: Quebranta 70%, Italia 20% and Torontel 10%.

Aromas of ripe vine, orchard fruit, nice floral and citrus notes, complimented with pastry notes. Fruit on the nose is amplified on the palate joined by hints of caramel, spices and pecans. Finishes with a soft and delicate long finish.

#### BARSOL PISCO SELECTO TORONTEL 14

Distilled from partially fermented wine made of 100% Torontel grapes from the Southern Ica and Ocucaje valleys in Ica, Peru.

Aromas of white and purple flowers combined with some citrus blossoms and herbal peppery notes.

Sweet dark berry fruit begins on the palate, combined with hints of lemongrass, anise and allspice, and a light lemon candy note.

#### BARSOL PISCO PURO ITALIA 14

Distilled from fresh wine made of 100% Italia grapes from the Valley of Ica, Peru.

On the nose aromas are extremely complex, with a wide variety of aromas to honey suckle, rose petals, hibiscus, tropical fruits, mango, passion fruit, melon, ripe pineapple, citrus notes. Tastes of guava, passion fruit, melon, honey dew, pineapple, green apple, honey, golden raisin. Finishes well structured, balanced, smooth, lingering, sophisticated and sensual.

#### MACCHU PISCO 12

Made from the assertive Quebranta grape. Light vanilla, lime peel, and white pepper make up a very light nose. On the palate, white pepper, vanilla sugar, wet cement, lime, yuzu, and cinnamon. There is a nice peppery bite at the end and a bit of earthiness present as well. The finish is quick and leaves the palate ready for another sip.

#### APPLETON SIGNATURE BLEND 11

Fifteen select aged rums, aged for an average of 4 years (from a variety of styles and ages) are blended and then rested together again in oak to allow the character, flavor, and bouquet to fuse.

#### APPLETON 12 YEAR RARE CASK 13

A blend of rare hand-selected pot and column still rums crafted with limestone-filtered water, all aged for a minimum of 12 years in the tropical climate of Jamaica.

#### BARRELL SINGLE BARREL RUM #J860 27

The base rum, which is from Jamaica, makes up 86% of the final blend. The marrying and finishing were done in a Canadian Rye barrel. 129.48pf

#### BATAVIA ARRACK VAN OOSTEN 11

The spirit that made "Punch" famous in the late 17th-19th century. Made from sugar cane and fermented red rice. Combines smoky fruitiness with a vegetal funk

#### CAPTAIN MORGAN SPICED RUM 9

#### CRUZAN BLACK STRAP 10

From St. Croix, a traditional, heavier rum made from the blackstrap molasses of sugar cane. Robust and dark flavors, with pancake syrup and vanilla attributes throughout.

#### COPALLI WHITE RUM 10

100% organic and sustainably farmed sugarcane from Belize. Nose of Vanilla, coffee bean, and a bright grassy note. Tastes of fresh strawberry, lime, and citrus zest. Staddles the line between a rum and a funky Agricole, with a slight bit of Jamaican essence on top.

#### COPALLI CACAO FLAVORED WHITE RUM 11

White rum that is rested with 100% organic, freshly harvested organic Cacao nibs. Over several weeks, the Cacao nibs infuse a rich chocolate flavor and aroma. Nose is distinctively cacao. Tastes like Belizean chocolate, along with the flavors of berries and a rich, balanced coco flavor. Long and creamy finish.

#### COPALLI BARREL RESTED RUM 12

Nose of vanilla, oak, and leather. Tastes of Cinnamon spice and Nutmeg, with hints of Blackberries and a grounded Tobacco essence. Aged in ex-bourbon barrels.

#### COPALLI BARREL RESTED CASK STRENGTH 14

Hints of coconut and time in the barrel fill the nose. A tropical medley that comes from being distilled from heirloom sugar cane is in the mouth with a medium finish with a continued oak presence. 118pf

#### DENIZEN 3 YEAR AGED 10

Tropical floral and fruit notes of coconut, mango and pineapple. Medium to full-bodied palate, with grassy notes. Hints of vanilla and subtle woody notes on the finish.

#### DENIZEN VATTED DARK RUM 11

Blend of 80% Dark Rum from Guyana and 20% Rhum Agricole from Martinique. Incredibly floral aromas encapsulate tropical fruit and some earthier elements in the nose. Opens up sweet in the mouth, with brown sugar crusted peach and star fruit. Flavors of green plantains are strong throughout the baking spice flecked finish.

#### DENIZEN MERCHANT'S RESERVE 8 YEAR 12

Consists of aged pot still rums from Jamaica (80% Plummer Style) and Rhum Grand Arome from Martinique (20%). Intensely aromatic and unapologetically funky, revealing bright fruity caramel flavors balanced by earthy notes that lead to along smooth spicy finish.

#### DIPLOMATICO PLANAS 10

A unique white rum aged for up to six years. Fresh and tropical aromas lead on to slightly fruity and creamy flavors and a delicate yet pronounced finish.

#### DIPLOMATICO MANTUANO 11

Blend of rums aged for up to eight years. Opens up with aromas of dried plums, oak and a delicate spiciness, it is complex and well-balanced on the palate, following on with notes of dried fruits, wood and vanilla.

#### DIPLOMATICO RESERVA EXCLUSIVA 12

Blend of exclusive rum reserves aged for up to twelve years, carefully selected by our Master Blenders. Opening up with aromas of orange peel, toffee and licorice, it is smooth on the palate, and follows on with notes of toffee fudge that offers a seductive, long-lasting finish.

#### DON PAPA SMALL BATCH 12

From the Philippines. Aged 7 years in ex-bourbon barrels, with notes of vanilla, honey, and candied fruits. Smooth and delicious, with a long and textured finish.

#### DON PAPA 10 YEAR 18

Aged an additional 7 years, with the ex-bourbon barrels re-charred, resulting in a darker and bolder rum with notes of dried fruit, cacao, and a hint of oak.

#### EL DORADO 12 YEAR 12

Demerara rum from Guyana. Lush tropical fruit and spice nose with hints of honey and dark sugar. The profile is round, mellow and full bodied with rich flavors of fruits and spice. The finish is delightful, elegant and dry.

#### FLOR DE CANA 4 YEAR SECO 10

Aroma with notes of sweet almonds and vanilla. Notes of white chocolate and orange essence, with a dry finish. Nicaraguan.

### **FOURSQUARE MARK XVII 2009 12 YEAR 22**

A blend of rums distilled in copper double retort pot still and the continuous twin column still for Foursquare and aged for 12 years in ex-bourbon barrels. 2009 is bright and fruit forward, while still showing great depth and complexity from aging entirely under a tropical climate. It showcases significant red fruits – both dried and fresh–brown butter, baking spices, and nuttiness indicative of long aging. The mouth feel is complex and lingering –with nice oak tannins throughout. Non-chilled filtered. Barbados.

### **GUSTOSO AGUARDIENTE GUARAPO 11**

100% fermented cane juice twice, bottled at high proof. Bright, bold aromas of fresh cane stalks and ripe banana peel, yeasty and vegetal. Layers of roasted pineapple, sweet plantain and fresh cut herbs give way to a pleasantly lingering meringue finish. 100% locally grown sugarcane grown exclusively in the highlands of Michoacan, Mexico.

### **JUNG & WULFF NO.1 TRINIDAD 13**

Delightfully flavorful 86-proof, medium-bodied impression of moderate age and medium-level oakiness. Deeply spicy, highlights of fruit, spice, vegetation, and earthiness

### **JUNG & WULFF NO. 2 GUYANA 13**

a beguiling, flavorful taste profile. the toasted opening is rich and creamy in texture, confectionary at the start. it becomes roasted and bittersweet and slightly smoky with an undercurrent of grassiness at the midpalate.

### **JUNG & WULFF NO. 3 BARBADOS 13**

full-bodied, buttery, aged rum that exemplifies its Barbados terroir. Early on the palate is a range of tastes from dark chocolate, to dried fruits, to burnt sugar. Creamy and robust, it is more bittersweet than sweet, deeply cocoa-like and deliciously rich.

### **KASAMA AGED 7 YEARS 10**

Distilled from freshly pressed noble cane juice in the Phillipines, then aged in American oak barrels. Sweet pineapple flavor, with a hint of vanilla, and a pinch of sea salt. Kasama means "together" in Filipino.

### **MOUNT GAY ECLIPSE GOLD RUM 10**

barbadian rum with distinctive notes of vanilla and banana, with underlying notes of caramel, summer fruit and spice. an oaky character from aging in charred ex-american whiskey oak with slight burnt notes. light to medium body.

### **MOUNT GAY BLACK BARREL RUM 13**

woody and butter notes balanced with dried fruit and spices. Aromatic notes of gingerbread, lychee, and toffee. Warm, medium body with a long finish. matured in ex-american whiskey cask and finished in heavily charred ex-bourbon cask.

### **PLANTATION ISLE OF FIJI DOUBLE BARREL 10**

Intense nose starts on molasses, pear and varnish, before becoming fruitier and spicier on apple, banana and gooseberry, also nutmeg and vanilla with a hint of smoke. palate is rich and round, with vanilla fudge, honey, ginger and fruity notes of prune and coconut. finish is very long on dried banana, bourbon and allspice. Tropical aging for 2 to 3 years in Bourbon casks followed by continental aging for 1 year in Ferrand casks

### **PLANTATON BARBADOS AGED 5 YEARS RUM 10**

Aromatics are all about baking shop fragrances, but also pipe tobacco, toasted marshmallow; secondary whiffs after further aeration discover bacon fat, black raisin, prune. Palate entry is bittersweet, roasted; midpalate is engagingly toasty, nearly fruity, as in baked orchard fruits, and resinous. Finishes medium long, chocolaty. Tropical aging for 3 to 4 years in Bourbon casks followed by continental aging for 1 to 2 years in Ferrand casks.

### **PLANTATION XAYMACA JAMAICAN RUM 10**

Complex nose, slightly smoky and meaty with fruity, herbal and sour notes building up. Next vanilla come forward, almost pastry-like, with cooked banana, bitter orange peel and ripe pineapple.

Dry, with a more floral and fruitier profile of rose water, sourdop, pear, white grape, apricot and sugar-apple. Next some coconut milk, balsam, allspices, bread and nuts emerge. Tropical aging for approximately 1 to 3 years in Bourbon casks followed by continental aging for 1 year in Ferrand casks.

### **PLANTATION STIGGINS' FANCY PINEAPPLE 10**

A rich and delicious bouquet, accented by smoky notes and aromas of tropical fruit, pineapple, citrus peel, and a touch of clove. The palate opens with a structured, pleasant sensation of ripe banana, pineapple, and spices layered in a smoky finish.

Blend of Jamaica, Barbados, and Trinidad Rums.

### **PLANTATION O.F.T.D OVERPROOF 10**

Old Fashioned Traditional Dark. Intense nose and precise notes of coffee, orange, plum, jam and truffles. Palate bursts with caramel cream, chocolate and vanilla notes. Continues with cinnamon, raisins, nutmeg, oak and molasses with smoky accents. Long and lingering finish with dark chocolate, clove and caramel. Blend of Jamaican, Guyana, and Barbados Rum.

### **PLANTATION TRINIDAD 1997 SINGLE CASK 18**

original, starts on a smoky, peaty, earthy profile with black pepper. it Evolves on lemon peel, butterscotch and nougat. rich and complex, it offers a fruitier profile of cooked pear, peach and starfruit with notes of nutmeg, vanilla and macchiato and a hint of malted barley. tropical aging for 15.5 years in bourbon casks and continental aging for 6 years in ferrand cognac casks.

Tropical ageing of 8 -15 years. The rums are chosen for their structure with aromatic characteristics suited for intensive oak ageing. Continental ageing of 2-10 years. The initial taste is one of sweetness, characterized by an intriguing accent of orange. This is followed by the characteristically bitter taste of the quina and ends on a sweet note. The name translates to "point and a half" and, so the story goes, it's one part vermouth and half a part intensely herbal-bitter quina liqueur.

### RAMAZZOTTI AMARO 10

The citrus flavor group key characteristic comes from distilled orange peel, which gives the Amaro a delicately fresh citrus aroma that delights the senses with its sweet succulence.

### VARNELLI AMARO DELL'ERBORISTA 14

Contains herbs and roots typical on Monti Sibillini which are prepared as a decoction over a wood fire with other Italian and exotic herbs, roots, and barks such as Citrus Aurantium, Citrus Sinensis, Cinchona Succirubra, Cinnamomum Zeylanicum, Rheum Officinale, and Syzygium Aromaticum. Only wildflower honey from the nearby mountain is used to sweeten the blend. Cloudy from being unfiltered, but the bitterness is a cornerstone. 21% abv

### VECCHIO AMARO DEL CAPO 10

A mix of twenty-nine herbs, flowers, fruits and roots from Calabria's beautiful land, blended to provide an intense experience of pleasure: the bittersweet taste of oranges, the delicacy of orange blossom and chamomile, the intensity of licorice, peppermint and aniseed. Vecchio recommended serving chilled.

### **FERNET**

#### **BITTERMENS SALMIAKKI DALA FERNET 11**

Scandinavian Fernet. Made with a combination 10 botanicals including saffron, aloe, licorice root, sal ammoniac, anise and chicory, this is a bitter salt-liquorice-flavoured spirit.

#### **BRANCA MENTA 10**

More mint-forward than Fernet Branca, with a touch more sweetness and less full-bodied. Its formula, composed of herbs and spices, is enriched with Piedmontese peppermint, one of the most precious essential oils in the world.

#### **CONTRATTO FERNET 11**

barbera-based grape distillate sourced from estate-grown fruit. extracts of 33 different herbs, spices, roots and seeds, including aloe, licorice, saffron, anise, fennel, ginger, mint, myrrh, juniper, nutmeg, cinnamon, rhubarb, quassia, clove and milk thistle

#### **FERNET BRANCA 10**

27 herbs, roots and spices that make up its secret and unique special formula

#### **FERENT DEL FRATE 22**

The saffron aromas mix with lightly mentholated and medicinal notes. The bitterness is immediately detected on the first sip, but evolves with light mint, menthol flavors that are surprisingly balanced and a subtle sweetness carries the finish on for a long while, as the bitterness becomes surprisingly engaging. The various known recipes most typically share ingredients such as aloe, saffron, quinquina, gentian, anise, angelica, mint and myrrh. This latter ingredient (along with saffron) seems to define and create the backbone of the best Fernet. 44% abv

#### **FERNET-VALLET 8**

made from a maceration of aromatic plants, roots and spices including cinnamon, clove, quassia wood, gentian root and cardamom. An intensely herbal, woody digestif, Fernet-Vallet enjoys popular usage throughout Mexico in the preparation of both classic and modern cocktails. 35% abv

#### **JELINEK FERNET 10**

Mint on the nose. Herbal influences dominate the palate, especially anise, with flavors of clove, raisins and mint that fade into a gently bitter finish. Created during the period of the Habsburg dynasty in the latter part of the 19th century in the region of central Europe near the famous health spa town of Luhačovice, Czech Republic. 38% abv

#### **LEOPOLD HIGHLAND FERNET AMARO 10**

The Fernet Leopold Highland Amaro embraces the herbal notes of traditional fernet, while offering a pronounced mint note. By steeping a flight of bitter roots in our neutral grain spirit followed by rose petals, elderflower, chamomile, and honeysuckle, depth and a complex finish is developed. Afterwards these ingredients will rest for weeks before they are drained and racked into Chardonnay barrels aging. Every barrel is then bottled by hand to preserve the integrity of the flavor and aroma. 40% abv

#### **LUXARDO FERNET AMARO 10**

A strong bitter amaro, Luxardo Fernet undergoes a prolonged infusion of different herbs and spices such as licorice, cardamom, gentian and saffron. Luxardo has produced this Fernet since 1889, and it is typically enjoyed after any meal to help digestion.

#### **MELETTI FERNET 8**

Herbaceous with balsamic notes. On the palate, a beginning of spice evolves to balsamic with mint, and finishes with bitter gentian root. It has a very long and persistent finish, clean and balanced.
